EXHIBIT "A"

AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VI OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BOCA DELRAY ASSOCIATION, INC.

It is proposed that Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation of Boca Delray Association, Inc. entitled "Directors", be amended as follows: The language added is <u>underlined</u>; the language deleted is struck out:

- A. The affairs and property of the Association shall be managed and governed by the Board of Directors composed of not less than three persons (Directors), but always an odd number of persons. The first Board of Directors shall have three (3) members and in the future, the number shall be determined from time to time in accordance with the By-Laws of the Association.
- B. Directors shall be elected by the Members in accordance with the By-Laws at the regular annual meetings of the membership of the Association. Directors shall be elected to serve for a term of one (1) year commencing with the 1990 Annual Election in the manner provided in the By Laws and, In the event of a vacancy, the remaining Directors may shall appoint a Director to serve the balance of said unexpired term. The appointed Director shall come from the same sector (private homes or multi-family) of the community as the Director whose leaving has created the vacancy. The Directors named herein shall serve until the first election of a Director or Directors as provided in the By-Laws and any vacancies in their number occurring before the first election shall be filled by the remaining Directors.

The adoption of this amendment shall be deemed to be retroactive to November 6, 1989 and shall thereby be in effect immediately and henceforth.
