#### TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### OF INFORMED FAMILIES OF DADE COUNTY, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1007 of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act (the "Act"), the undersigned Corporation adopts the following amended and restated articles of incorporation.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the company believe it is in the best interest of the company to change its name from The Informed Families of Dade County, Inc. to The Informed Families/The Florida Family Partnership, Inc. (the "Corporation");.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors desire to amend the original Articles of Incorporation dated December 17, 1982 (the "Original Articles") as set forth below:

1. Article I Name. The name of the Corporation is The Informed Families/The Florida Family Partnership, Inc.

On September 22,2002, these Articles of Amendment were approved by the Board of Directors of the Corporation and such approval is sufficient for the amendment to the Original Articles.
