

## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT SECRETARY OF COMMON TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF AHASSEE, FOR IRONWOOD FOURTEENTH CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC. DOCUMENT NUMBER OF CORPORATION: 767732

Pursuant to provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

1. The Articles of Incorporation have been amended as follows:

(text in strike-through format indicate deletions; underlined text indicates additions)

Article IX The By-Laws shall be amended in the manner provided by the By-Laws.

The By Laws of the corporation shall initially be made and adopted by the first Board of Directors.

——Prior to the time the property described in Article II hereinabove has bee submitted to Condominium ownership by filing of the Declaration of Condominium, said first Board of Directors shall have full-power to amend, alter or rescind-said By-Laws by a-majority vote.

——After the property described in Article II hereinabove has been submitted to Condominium ownership by the filing of the Declaration of Condominium, the By-Laws may be amended, altered, supplemented or modified by the membership at the Annual Meeting, or at a duly convened special meeting of the membership attended by a majority of membership, by-vote, as follows:

- A. If the proposed change has been approved by the unanimous approval of the Board of Directors, then it shall require only a majority vote of the membership to be adopted.
- B. If the proposed change has not been approved by the unanimous vote of the Board of Directors, then the proposed change must be approved by three-fourths (3/4ths) of the total vote of the membership;

Provided, however, that (1) prior to the first Annual Meeting of the Membership, the By-Laws may not be amended without a prior resolution requesting said Amendment by the Board of Directors of the Association; and (2) subsequent to the first Annual Meeting of the Membership, the By-Laws may not be amended without the approval of the Board of Directors of the Association, unless the proposed Amendment shall be filed in writing with the Secretary or President, not less than ten (10) days prior to the membership meeting at which such Amendment is to be voted upon. Provided, further, that after the property described in Article II has been submitted to Condominium ownership, the By-Laws may only be amended with the written approval of the Developer referred to in said Declaration, where said Amendment changes the rights and privileges of said Developer.

2.	The date of adoption of the amendments was on	MAY 19.
2022, and it is	effective upon its recording in the Public Records	s of Manatee County, FL

3. The amendments were approved and adopted by the members of the Association and the number of votes cast for the amendments was sufficient for approval.
