The undersigned parties, being legally and formally empowered by their respective Boards of Directors to do so, do hereby determine to merge The Napoleonic Association, Inc., a Florida Corporation, into The Napoleonic Society of America, Inc., also a Florida Corporation. The undersigned also hereby ratify and adopt the following "Plan of Merger," such term to be given the meaning contemplated by 617 Florida Statutes §1101:

<u> Article I - Name of Merged Corporation</u>

The name of the surviving corporation after merger shall be The Napoleonic Society of America, Inc.

Article II - Address

The Napoleonic Society of America shall continue to maintain its principal office at 1115 Ponce de Leon Boulevard, Clearwater, Florida 34616, or at such other location as the Directors shall from time to time designate as the principal location of the Corporation as they may see fit.

Article III - Assets and Liabilities

The Napoleonic Association hereby relinquishes and the Napoleonic Society of America hereby accepts all of the assets and liabilities of the Napoleonic Association, Inc., including any and all real estate, personal property including membership lists and records, choses in action, or otherwise.

Article IV - Nature of Merged Business

The purposes for which the merged entity bearing the name "Napoleonic Society of America, Inc." shall be organized are the same as those which were more fully enumerated in the Articles of Incorporation of the Napoleonic Society of America, Inc. which were filed with the Secretary of State, Corporation Bureau of the State
