AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

SAND ALL

PRIVATE INDUSTRY COUNCIL OF OKALOOSA, SANTA ROSWALTON COUNTY CONSORTIUM INC.

(the "Corporation")

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1002. Florida Statutes, the undersigned, being Chairperson of the Corporation, and having been duly authorized by the Board of Directors of the Corporation to formally document its actions amending the Articles of Incorporation, intends to amend the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

1. Article III, of the Articles of Incorporation shall be amended to read as follows:

"Article III:

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to provide employment and training and related services for all, especially for economically disadvantaged adults and youth, dislocated workers, persons with disabilities, public assistance recipients, at-risk youth and others with barriers to employment; to prepare these individuals to meet the needs of the local labor market; to provide recruitment, out-placement, and workforce development services for the business community.

Accordingly, the purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

These purposes will be accomplished by solicitation and acceptance of other public and private contributions.

No part of the earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of

statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)"

3. There shall be added a new Article X to the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

"Article X:

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended from time to time at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors of the Corporation by a majority vote of the Directors then in office."
