



GEORGIA, MUSCOGEE COUNTY.

TO THE SUPERIOR COURT OF SAID COUNTY:

The petition of Fred Woolard, Marshall L. Leary, E. K. Leary, J. R. Gresh, Jemima Bishop, Angie Lynch, and Ben C. Hamilton, all of Muscogee County, Georgia, and J. B. Bearden, of Jefferson County, Alabama; C. B. Hordic, of Hinds County, Mississippi, and S. S. Corey, of Duval County, Florida, and Horace Dugas, of the State of Louisiana, respectfully shows:

1. That there has been established in said County and State a Church known as the SANCTIFIED CHURCH OF CHRIST, and petitioners show that said church desires to be incorporated and made a body politic under the name and style of SANCTIFIED CHURCH OF CHRIST, for a period of nine hundred and ninety-nine years, with the right of renewal at the expiration of that time by compliance with the laws of the State of Georgia.

2.

Petitioners show that said church desires the right to enforce good order, receive donations, make purchases and affect alienation of realty and personality, not for the purpose of trade and profit but promoting the general design of said church, and to look after the general interests of said church, and said church has no desire to operate for the purpose of pecuniary gain or profit for itself or of any of its members.

3.

Petitioners show that the principal office and place of business of said church is to be located in the City of Columbus, County of Muscogee, and State of Georgia, but said petitioners desire the right to establish branch churches throughout the State of Georgia, and in any other state or nation in which it may be first to carry on its religious activities, and that it shall have the right to establish such Councils as may be necessary in other states.

or in the State of Georgia, but all such Councils so established
are to be subordinate to the General Council of said church in the
City of Columbus, Georgia.

4. Petitioners further show that they desire that said church shall
be vested with the right to appoint a General Council consisting
of twelve members, which said Council shall be the ruling body of
such church, and shall meet in conference each year not later than
the fourth day of July. That the title to the real estate of
such church shall be vested in a Board of Trustees who shall be
appointed by the Council of said church, and the first Board of
Trustees shall consist of the following named members of said
church, to-wit: Arthur F. Woolard, Jessie Bonner, Lena DeFrene,
L. J. Gray, Marvin Langston, and Conley White, and the title taken
to any property, real or personal, in the names of said trustees
for said church shall vest in such trustees for the use and benefit
of said church, and their successors in trust from time to time.

That said church shall have the right to establish any other
governing board or body that it may deem necessary for the carrying
on of its various duties and functions.

6.

That said church shall have the right to borrow money and to
secure the payment of said money by mortgages, security deeds, or
otherwise, and to execute notes, contracts, or other forms or
evidences of indebtedness.

7.

That said church shall have and use a common seal, shall have
the right to sue and be sued, to contract and be contracted with,
and such other general and incidental powers as may be allowed to
like corporations under the laws of the State of Georgia.

That said church shall have the right to establish conferences as it may deem advisable in the carrying on of its work, that said church may approve and accept a discipline for the governing of its church body, and its membership, which shall be binding upon all of the governing bodies of such church, the trustees, and the membership thereof.

That a certified copy of this petition, together with the order of the court thereon, shall be evidence of the incorporation of said church.

WHEREFORE, petitioners pray that said church may be granted corporate existence and made a body corporate and politic as provided under Section 22-401 and other sections of the Code of Georgia of 1933 relating to incorporation of churches, their organization and conduct, and petitioners further pray that said church may be clothed with all the general and incidental powers as may be granted under the laws of the State of Georgia to corporations of like character.

ORDER.

The above and foregoing petition for incorporation of a church to be known as

"SANCTIFIED CHURCH OF CHRIST"

coming on for hearing and consideration by this Court, and it appearing that all of the facts and things as set forth in said petition are true, it is hereby, ordered, adjudged and decreed by

this Court that said "SANCTIFIED CHURCH OF CHRIST" be and the same is hereby chartered as a corporation for a term of nine hundred and ninety-nine years, with the right of renewal at the expiration of that time by compliance with the laws of the State of Georgia.

Said "SANCTIFIED CHURCH OF CHRIST" is hereby vested with the right to enforce good order, receive donations, make purchases and effect alienations of realty and personality, not for the purpose of trade and profit but promoting the general design of said church and to look after the general interest of said church.

That the principal office and place of business of said Church is to be located in the City of Columbus, Muscogee County, Georgia but said Church shall have the right to establish branch churches throughout the State of Georgia, and in any other State or nation in which it may desire to carry on its religious activities, and it shall have the right to establish such Councils as may be necessary in other States, or in the State of Georgia, but all such Councils so established are to be subordinate to the General Council of said Church in the City of Columbus, Georgia.

That said Church shall have the right to appoint a General Council consisting of twelve members, which said Council shall be the ruling body of such church, and shall meet in conference each year not later than the fourth day of July. That the title to the real estate of such church shall be vested in a Board of Trustees who shall be appointed by the Council of said church, and the first Board of Trustees shall consist of the following named members of said church to-wit: Arthur F. Woolard, Bossie Bonner, Lena DuFrene, L. J. Gray, Marvin Langston, and Conley White, and the title taken to any property, real or personal, in the name of said trustees for said church shall vest in such trustees for the use and benefit of said Church, and their successors in trust from time to time.

That said church shall have the right to establish any other governing board or body that it may deem necessary for the carrying on of its various duties and functions.

That said church shall have the right to borrow money and to secure the payment of said money by mortgages, security deeds, or otherwise, and to execute notes, contracts, or other forms of evidences of indebtedness, and that said church shall have and use a common seal, shall have the right to sue and be sued, to contract and be contracted with, and such other general and incidental powers as are allowed to like corporations under the laws of this State.

Said church shall have the right to establish conferences as it may deem advisable in the carrying on of its work, that said church may approve and accept discipline for the governing of its church body and its membership, which shall be binding upon all of the governing bodies of such church, the trustees, and the membership thereof.

It is further ordered by this Court that a certified copy of the petition for incorporation, together with this order, shall be evidence of the incorporation of said "SANCTIFIED CHURCH OF CHRIST".

Said Church is hereby decreed to be clothed with all of the general and incidental powers as may be granted under the laws of the State of Georgia to corporations of like character, and is declared to be within the purview of the laws of the State of Georgia, and that the grant of said charter is not contrary to the laws of Georgia nor violative of any private rights.

And it being made further to appear that the petitioners for said charter are discreet and proper persons, said petition is granted to said petitioners and their legal successors as in said petition prayed and as in this order provided.


