

Caldwell and Homer Crawford, being, respectively, the President and the Secretary of St. Regis Paper Company, a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, said St. Regis Paper Company owning all of the issued and outstanding shares of the capital stock of St. Regis Pulp and Paper Corporation, a foreign corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, do hereby certify and set forth as follows:
