



(50,000) shares are classified as First Preferred Stock of the par value of \$100 each and twenty-five million (25,000,000) shares are classified as Common Stock of the par value of \$5 each, to one hundred and twenty-five million dollars (\$125,000,000) divided into twenty-five million (25,000,000) shares classified as Common Stock of the par value of \$5 each. To accomplish such reduction, Article III of the Certificate of Incorporation of the Corporation, as heretofore amended, is further amended to read and be as follows:


"III. The amount of the capital stock of the Corporation shall be one hundred and twenty-five million dollars (\$125,000,000) divided into the five million (25,000,000) shares classified as Common Stock of the par value of five dollars (\$5) each. None of the shares of the Corporation shall be without par value."

(b) Article IV, setting forth provisions relating to First Preferred Stock of the Corporation, is eliminated from the Certificate of Incorporation of the Corporation; and

(c) Articles V to X, inclusive, of the Certificate of Incorporation of the Corporation are renumbered to be Articles IV to IX, respectively.

4. The foregoing amendments of the Certificate of Incorporation of the Corporation were authorized by the vote of the holders of more than a majority of the outstanding shares of the Corporation's Common Stock at the Annual Meeting of such
