#### AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

### AMERICAN COMMERCE INSURANCE COMPANY (Formerly Automobile Club Insurance Company)

FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be American Commerce Insurance Company.

SECOND: The place in Ohio where its principal office shall be located is in the City of Columbus, Franklin County, Ohio.

THIRD: The purpose of the corporation shall be to transact, directly or by ceding or assuming reinsurance, any one or more of all of the kinds of insurance described in and authorized by Section 3941.02 of the Ohio Revised Code as it now exists or may hereafter be amended. The corporation shall have the power and authority to exercise any and all rights, powers, and privileges, and shall be subject to any and all duties and obligations, now or hereafter granted to or imposed upon domestic insurance companies formed for the purpose of transacting such insurance by the laws of the State of Ohio, and the corporation shall have the power and authority to engage in any act or activity which is not unlawful for it under the laws of the State of Ohio.

FOURTH: The authorized number of shares of the corporation shall be 1,000,000, all of which shall be common shares, each with a par value of \$25.00 per share.


FIFTH: The paid-in capital of the corporation shall be not less than \$1,000,000 and the contributed surplus of the corporation shall be not less than \$1,500,000.

SIXTH: The Directors of the corporation shall have the power to cause the corporation from time to time and at any time to purchase, hold, sell, transfer or otherwise deal with (A) shares of any class or series issued by it, (B) any security or other obligation of the corporation which may confer upon the holder thereof the right to convert the same into shares of any class or series authorized by the Articles of the corporation, and (C) any security or other obligation which may confer upon the holder thereof the right to purchase shares of any class or series authorized by the Articles of the corporation. The corporation shall have the right to repurchase, if and when any shareholder desires to sell, or on the happening of any event is required to sell, shares of any class or series issued by the corporation. The authority granted in this Article Sixth of these Articles shall not limit the plenary authority of the Directors to purchase, hold, sell, transfer or otherwise deal with shares of any class or series, securities, or other obligations issued by the corporation or authorized by its Articles.

SEVENTH: No shareholder of the corporation shall have, as a matter of right, the preemptive right to purchase or subscribe for shares of any class, now or hereafter authorized, or to purchase or subscribe for securities or other obligations convertible into or exchangeable for such shares or which by warrants or otherwise entitle the holders thereof to subscribe for or purchase any such share.

<u>EIGHTH</u>: These Amended Articles of Incorporation supercede and take the place of the Amended Articles of Incorporation of the corporation in effect as of the date hereof.
