## SAFECO INSURANCE COMPANY OF INDIANA

The undersigned, acting as incorporators for the purpose of redomesticating SAFECO Insurance Company of Pennsylvania, a Pennsylvania corporation, which intends to continue its existence, without interruption, as a corporation organization and lawfully incorporated under the laws of the state of Indiana, pursuant to Indiana Business Corporation Law and IC 27-1-6 of the Indiana Insurance Code, under the name SAFECO Insurance Company of Indiana, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Redomestication and Amended Articles of Incorporation for said corporation.

ARTICLE 1. The name by which the Company shall be known is SAFECO Insurance Company of Indiana.

ARTICLE 2. The classes of insurance for which the Company is constituted are those in Class 2 and Class 3 as provided for in Indiana Code Section 27-1-5-1, including:

Class 2

- (a) To insure any persons against bodily injury, disablement or death resulting from accident and against disablement resulting from disease and every insurance appertaining thereto;
- (b) To insure against loss or damage resulting from accident to, or injury sustained by, an employee or other person for which accident or injury the insured is liable;
- (c) To insure against loss or damage by burglary, theft or housebreaking;
- (d) To insure glass, its fittings or lettering thereon, against breakage or damage;
- (e) To insure against loss from injury to persons or property which results accidentally from steam-boilers, elevators, electrical devices, engines and all machinery and appliances used in connection therewith or operated thereby; and to make inspection of and issue certificates of inspection upon such boilers, elevators, electrical devices, engines, machinery and appliances;
- (f) To insure against any loss, expense, and/or liability resulting from the ownership, maintenance, use and/or operation of any automobile or other motor vehicle, including complete line coverage on automobiles or other motor vehicles;

- (g) To insure against loss or damage by water to any goods or premises arising from the breakage or leakage of sprinklers and/or water pipes;
- (h) To insure against any loss or damage resulting from accident to or injury suffered by any person, for which loss or damage the insured is liable; excepting employer's liability insurance as authorized under subsection (b) of Class 2;
- To insure persons, associations or corporations against loss or damage by reason of the giving or extending of credit;
- (j) To insure against loss or damage on account of encumbrances upon or defects in the title to real estate and against loss by reason of the nonpayment of the principal or interest of bonds, mortgages or other evidences of indebtedness;
- (k) To become surety or guarantor for any person, partnership or corporation in any position or place of trust or as custodian of money or property, public or private; to become a surety or guarantor for the performances by any person, copartnership or corporation of any lawful obligation, undertaking, agreement or contract of any kind, except contracts or policies of insurance, to become surety or guarantor for the performance of insurance contracts where surety bonds are required by states or municipalities; and
- (1) To insure against any other casualty or insurance risk specified in these Articles of Incorporation which lawfully may be made the subject of insurance and for which specific provision is not made in Indiana Code Title 27, Article 1, Chapter 5.

Class 3

- (a) To make insurance on buildings and personal property of every description against loss or damage, including loss of use or occupancy, cause by fire, smoke or smudge, lightning or other electrical disturbance, earthquake, windstorm, cyclone, tornado, tempest, hail, frost or snow, ice, sleet, weather or climactic conditions, including excess or deficiency of moisture, flood, rain or drought, rising of the waters of the ocean, or its tributaries, bombardment, invasion, insurrection, riot, civil war or commotion, military or usurped power, and by explosion, whether fire ensues or not, except explosion of steam-boilers;
- (b) To insure against loss or damage from any cause, to crops or farm products and loss of rental value of land used in producing such crops or products;
- (c) To insure against loss or damage by water or other fluid to any goods or premises arising from the breakage or leakage of sprinklers, pumps, or other apparatus erected for extinguishing fires or of other conduits or containers or by water entering through leaks or openings in buildings and/or water pipes, and against

accidental injury to such sprinklers, pumps, or other apparatus, conduits, containers or water-pipes; and

(d) To insure vessels, boats, cargoes, goods, merchandise, freight, specie, bullion, jewels, profits, commissions, bank notes, bills of exchange, other evidences of debt, bottomry and respondentia interests, and other property against loss or damage by any or all of the risks of lake, river, canal and inland navigation and transportation, and other insurances appertaining to or connected with marine risks, including complete line coverage automobile insurance, and also insurance on any other property or risk, or the use thereof, by reason of any contingency unless the granting of such insurance is contrary to public policy.

ARTICLE 3. The business is to be conducted on the joint stock plan or principle.

ARTICLE 4. The post office address of the principal office of the Company is to be 500 North Meridian Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204. The initial registered office of the Company is 500 North Meridian Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204. The initial registered agents are A. F. Coffey.

ARTICLE 5. The authorized capital stock of the Company is five hundred thousand (500,000) shares of common stock with a par value of ten dollars (\$10.00) per share. Three hundred thousand shares are issued and outstanding, for a total of three million dollars (\$3,000,000).

ARTICLE 6. The general objects of the Company are to make insurances on the joint stock principle against losses as set forth in Article 2 above.

ARTICLE 7. The proposed duration of the Company is perpetual.

ARTICLE 8. The powers which the Company shall have and exercise are:

- (a) To continue as a corporation, under its corporate name, for the period set forth in these Articles of Incorporation;
- (b) To sue and be sued in its corporate name;
- (c) To have a corporate seal and to alter the same at pleasure;
- (d) To acquire, own, hold, lease mortgage, lend, pledge, convey or otherwise dispose of property, real and personal, tangible and intangible;
- (e) To acquire, subscribe for, own, hold, vote mortgage, lend, pledge, convey, or otherwise dispose of, and to guarantee or otherwise deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of, any entity, including itself, except as otherwise prohibited or limited by law;

- (f) To be a promoter, partner, member, associate, or manager of any partnership, joint venture, trust, or other entity;
- (g) To borrow money, and to issue its notes or debentures to evidence such borrowings, but any debentures so issued shall be subordinate to the rights of policyholders, members, or creditors;
- (h) To conduct business in Indiana and elsewhere; to have one or more offices outside of Indiana; to acquire, own, hold and use, and to lease, mortgage, pledge, sell convey, or otherwise dispose of property, real and personal, tangible and intangible, outside of Indiana;
- (i) To appoint such officers and agents as the business of the Company may require, and to define their duties and fix their compensation;
- (j) To lend money, invest and reinvest its funds, and receive and hold real estate and personal property as security for repayment, except as otherwise limited by law;
- (k) To pay pensions and establish and administer pension plans, pension trusts, profit sharing plans, share bonus plans, share option plans, welfare plans, qualified and nonqualified retirement plans, and benefit or incentive plans for any or all of its current or former directors, officers, employees, and agents.
- (l) To make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific, or education purposes;
- (m) To make bylaws for the government and regulation of its affairs;
- (n) To cease doing business and to dissolve and surrender its corporate franchise and authority and license to transact an insurance business in this state; and
- (0) To do all acts and things necessary, convenient, or expedient to carry out the purposes for which it is formed.

ARTICLE 9. Meetings of Directors, shareholders, members or policyholders may be held inside or outside of Indiana, as the Directors may choose.

ARTICLE 10. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of the following individuals who shall hold office until the next meeting of shareholders and until their successors are elected and qualified:
