Restated Articles of Incorporation Southern Guaranty Insurance Company

The Restated Articles of Incorporation executed by the undersigned on September 22, 2005, to become effective on September 30, 2005, supersede and take the place of existing Restated Articles of Incorporation executed August 16, 1989 and filed in the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance, State of Alabama in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama:

Article I. The name of the corporation shall be Southern Guaranty Insurance Company.

Article II. The period of existence shall be perpetual.

Article III. The purpose shall be the transaction of an insurance business for the following purposes as provided in Chapter 610 and 611 of Wisconsin Insurance Laws:

- (a) Fire Insurance Against loss or damage to property, by fire, lightening, hail, tempest, explosion, and against any other loss or damage from any cause to property or in the use of, or income from property.
- (b) Marine Insurance Vessels, freight, goods, moneys, effects and money loaned on bottomry and respondentia, against the perils of the seas and other perils usually insured against by marine insurance, including the risks of inland transportation and navigation.
- (c) Disability Insurance Against bodily injury or death by accident, and upon the health of persons.
- (d) Liability Insurance (1) Against loss or damage by the sickness, personal injury, or death of any person and against loss or damage to the property of any person, for which loss or damage the insured is liable. (2) Against loss, expense and liability resulting from errors, omissions or neglect in the performance of any official vocational or professional service, but not including any insurance which is specified in Paragraph (1) or in Sub-Paragraph (f) or (m).
- (e) Steam Boiler Insurance Against loss or damage to the property of the insured or to the life, person or property of another, for which the insured is liable, caused by the explosion of steam boilers, pipes, engines, motors and machinery connected therewith or operated thereby.
- (f) Fidelity Insurance Against the loss from the defaults of persons in position of trust, public or private, and to guarantee the performance of contracts and obligations.
- (g) Burglary Insurance Against loss or damage by burglary or theft, or both.
- (h) Plate Glass Insurance Against the breakage of glass, located or in transit.
- (i) Sprinkler Leakage Insurance Against loss or damage by water, caused by the breakage of sprinklers, pumps, water pipes or plumbing, or its fixtures, and against accidental injury to such sprinklers and other apparatus.
- Elevator Insurance Upon elevators and vehicles, and to inspect the same and issue certificates thereof.

- (k) Livestock Insurance Against loss or damage to domestic animals, and to furnish the services of a veterinary surgeon for such animals
- (l) Automobile Insurance Against loss, expense and liability resulting from the ownership, maintenance or use of any automobile, aircraft or other vehicle.
- (m) Workmen's Compensation Insurance Against loss, damage or liability for or under Workmen's Compensation and including Employers' Liability Insurance when written in the same policy in connection with Workmen's Compensation insurance.
- (n) Other Casualty Insurance Against loss or damage to property by any other casualty which may lawfully be the subject of insurance, and for which no other provision is made by law.
- (o) Medical Payments and Other Supplemental Insurance Against expense, other than loss of time, in connection with the kinds of insurance specified in Sub-Paragraphs (d), (e), (g), (j), and (n), and against loss, damage and expense, including loss of time, in connection with the kind of insurance specified in Sub-Paragraph (l), arising out of bodily injury to, or sickness, disease or death of, either or both the insured and others, by accident, with respect to which the insurer assumes an obligation to pay irrespective of the insured's legal liability therefore.

Article IV. The capital stock of said corporation shall be Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000), and the same shall consist of Five Million shares (5,000,000), each of which shares shall be of the face value or par value of One Dollar (\$1.00).

Article V. The principal or home office of the corporation is One General Drive, Sun Prairie, State of Wisconsin. The corporation shall have its corporate existence with the State of Wisconsin as its corporate domicile.

Article Vi. The present registered agent at such address is Anne B. Smith.

Article VII. The number of the Board of Directors may be fixed by Bylaws to consist of not less than three and not more than twelve directors, the exact number within such limits to be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors.

Article VIII. The Board of Directors may permit the Company's policyholders from time to time to participate in the profits of the Company's operations through the payment of dividends, or through such other means as may be authorized or permitted by the laws of states in which the Company does business.

The Board of Directors shall have the power to make reasonable classifications or policies and to take such other action in accord with the law, as may be necessary or desirable to carry into effect any participation by policyholders in the profits of the Company's operations which the directors may authorized. No policyholders shall have any right to participate in the profits of the Company's operation unless or until the directors of the Company in the exercise of their discretion affirmatively authorize such participation and then only to the extent so authorized.

Article IX. These Articles may be amended in the manner authorized by law at the time of the amendment.
