

RESTATED ARTICLES AGREEMENT/INCORPORATION, INCLUDING DESIGNATED AMENDMENT(S)

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF RSA 401:6, THE UNDERSIGNED INSURANCE COMPANY, PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION(S) DULY ADOPTED BY ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND SOLE SHAREHOLDER, HEREBY ADOPTS THE RESTATED ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT/INCORPORATION SET FORTH BELOW, INCLUDING DESIGNATED AMENDMENT(S).

These Articles effect the redomestication to New Hampshire of Washington International Insurance Company, which was initially incorporated in Arizona on February 3, 1976.

FIRST:

The name of the corporation is Washington International Insurance Company (the

"Corporation").

SECOND:

The number of shares the Corporation is authorized to issue is 100,000 shares of

Common Stock, \$300.00 par value per share.

THIRD:

The address of the registered office of the Corporation is 650 Elm Street, Manchester, New Hampshire 03101 and the name of its registered agent at such address is Robert

M. Solitro.

FOURTH:

The capital stock will be sold or offered for sale within the meaning of RSA 421-B (New Hampshire Securities Act).

FIFTH:

The Corporation is empowered to transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated and the <u>principal</u> purposes for which the Corporation is formed are (i) to conduct the kinds of insurance business set forth in Paragraphs I, II, IV, V, VI and VII of Section 401:1 of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, as such may be amended from time to time, (ii) to conduct reinsurance business of the kinds of insurance set forth in Paragraphs I, II, IV, V, VI and VII of Section 401:1 of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, as such may be amended from time to time, and (iii) to conduct such insurance, reinsurance or other business as the Corporation may now or hereafter be permitted to transact under Title XXXVII of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, as such may be amended from time to time.

SIXTH:

No officer or director of the Corporation shall be personally liable to the Corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages for any action taken or any failure to take action as an officer or director, except for (1) the amount of a financial benefit received by a director or an officer to which he or she is not entitled, (2) for any intentional infliction of harm on the Corporation or the shareholders, (3) a violation of Section 293-A:8.33 of the Business Corporation Act of the State of New Hampshire, or (4) any intentional violation of criminal law. If the Business Corporation Act of the State of New Hampshire is amended to authorize corporate action further eliminating or limiting the personal liability of officers or directors, then the liability of an officer or director of the Corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by the Business Corporation Act of the State of New Hampshire as so amended. No repeal or amendment of this Article SEVENTH shall adversely affect any right or protection of an officer or director of the

IN THE MATTER OF Application for Approval of Redomestication of Foreign Insurer By Washington International Insurance Company

FINDINGS AND FINAL ORDER

The New Hampshire Insurance Commissioner Roger A. Sevigny (the "Commissioner") pursuant to RSA 405:62 and 405:64, has carefully considered the application of Washington International Insurance Company (Washington International) filed on September 15, 2008, as supplemented from time to time (the "Application"). The Application seeks approval for the redomestication of Washington International from Arizona, its current state of domicile to New Hampshire.

The Examination Division of the New Hampshire Insurance Department (the "Department") has completed a thorough review of the Application and has reviewed additional documentary information provided by the Applicant at the Department's request. Based upon the Application and the accompanying documents, the following findings of fact and conclusions of law have been reached:

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Washington International is an Arizona corporation. All of the outstanding stock of Washington International is owned by North American Specialty Insurance Company ("NAS"), a New Hampshire insurance corporation with its statutory home office at 650 Elm Street, Manchester, NH 03101.
- Washington International has proposed that it be redomesticated as a New Hampshire domestic insurance company by amending and restating its Articles of Incorporation to designate New Hampshire as its state of corporate domicile, effective as of September 30, 2008.
- 3. Based upon all of the material filed in this matter, the Commissioner finds that Washington International has complied with all requirements of New Hampshire law relative to the organization and licensing of a domestic insurer and has designated its principal place of business (statutory home office) in New Hampshire, and accordingly is qualified for redomestication as a New Hampshire domestic insurance company, pursuant to RSA 405:62 and 405:64.
- 4. Having considered the prototype policy forms in use by Washington International and in light of the fact that only the home office address will change, no forms filing will be necessitated by the redomestication.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED by the New Hampshire Insurance Commissioner that:

- A. The Application by Washington International for redomestication to New Hampshire, pursuant to and in accordance with RSA 405:62, is hereby APPROVED, with the redomestication to be effective as of September 30, 2008.
- B. The proposed Restated Articles of Incorporation Including Designated Amendments of Washington International, which were submitted as part of this proceedings, are hereby approved. Upon endorsement by the Commissioner, the duly certified Restated Articles of Incorporation shall be filed by Washington International with the New Hampshire Secretary of State as provided in RSA 401:8.
- C. Pursuant to RSA 405:64, the redomestication of Washington International shall have the following effects:
- i. The Certificates of Authority, licenses, producers' appointments, rates and all other incidents of authority to engage in the business of insurance of Washington International that are in existence as of the date hereof, shall continue in full force and effect so long as Washington International remains duly qualified to transact the business of insurance in New Hampshire.
- ii. The outstanding policies of Washington International shall remain in full force and effect and need not be endorsed as to its new state of domicile or new location; and
- iii. Washington International may continue to use existing policy forms until such time as applicant has filed new policy forms with, and has had such forms approved by, the New Hampshire Insurance Department.
