BE IT KNOWN that on the 2nd day of July, 1998, before me. Elaine Sabo ___, a Notary Public, duly commissioned and qualified in and for the county and state aforesaid, personally appeared FRANCES Y. BURNETTE, whose name is hereinafter affixed, along with her current address, who declared unto me, a Notary Public, that she is the Secretary of FIRST NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, an Alabama corporation; that the said corporation is availing itself of the provisions of the laws of the State of Mississippi relative to insurance companies and especially the provisions of Title 83 Chapter 19, §83-19-1, et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended; that the said FIRST NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA has authorized and directed the said FRANCES Y. BURNETTE to present the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Mississippi the attached ARTICLES OF REDOMESTICATION and AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION to redomesticate the corporation from the State of Alabama to the State of Mississippi in compliance with §83-20-1, et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, and to change the domicile of the corporation from Alabama to Mississippi in accordance with the following Articles of Redomestication and Amended and

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Restated Articles of Incorporation; and that for and on behalf of the corporation and, as the corporation's act and deed, she signed and delivered the following Articles of Redomestication and Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation on the date and year therein stated:

I.

The name of the corporation is First National Life Insurance Company of America (the "Company").

Π.

The Company is an Alabama domestic stock life, accident and sickness insurer with its principal place of business in the State of Alabama in the City of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama. The Company will file with the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Alabama a notice of intent to redomesticate from Alabama to the State of Mississippi pursuant to §27-3-31, Code of Alabama 1975.

Ш.

The Company is licensed as a foreign insurer in the State of Mississippi.

IV.

The Company shall be a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Mississippi upon the filing by the Company of these Articles of Redomestication and Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State of Mississippi after the approval of the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Mississippi.

V.

The Company was originally incorporated on July 24, 1936, as a fraternal benefit society, and on October 19, 1954, the Company was converted to its present form and its original

charter issued authorizing it to operate as a stock life insurance company under the laws of the State of Georgia. Thereafter said charter was duly amended on the following dates: April 25, 1960; June 30, 1965; June 8, 1971; December 13, 1978; May 4, 1984; December 28, 1990, and September 4, 1992. The Company redomesticated to the State of Alabama on September 4, 1992. The Company desires to amend its charter further, and the purpose of the amendment is to amend and restate its charter so as to reflect and effectuate a redomestication of the Company to the State of Mississippi.

Whereupon, after making the necessary filing and obtaining the requisite approvals in Mississippi and Alabama, the Company prays that, upon the effective date hereof, the charter of the Company shall be amended and restated to read as follows:

l.

The name of the Company is First National Life Insurance

The Company shall have a perpetual duration.

3.

The Company shall carry on the business of general ordinary life insurance, industrial or weekly premium life insurance, sickness, health, accident, hospitalization and other kinds of insurance business as are generally authorized by law for stock life insurance companies.

The Company is authorized to issue 10,000 shares of common stock which shall be divided into shares of a par value of \$150 per share. The Company shall not transact any business until it shall have a minimum of paid-in capital of \$400,000 and a minimum surplus of \$600,000.

5.

The location of the principal office of the Company shall be in the City of Jackson, Hinds County, Mississippi.

6.

The registered office of the Company shall be located at:

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than three nor more than twenty members. The current Board of Directors consists of the following individuals:

No director or officer of this corporation shall have any personal liability to the corporation or to its shareholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director or officer; provided, however, that this provision shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a director or officer (a) for the amount of financial benefit received by a director or officer to which he is not entitled; (b) for an intentional infliction of harm on the corporation or the shareholders; (c) for a violation of §79-4-8.33, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended; or (d) for intentional violation of criminal law.

The corporation shall indemnify any director or officer of the corporation for liability as defined in §79-4-8.50(5) of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, to any person for any action taken, or for failure to take any action, as a director or officer, except liability for (a) receipt of a financial benefit to which he is not entitled, (b) an intentional infliction of harm on the corporation or its shareholders; (c) a violation of §79-4-8.33, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended; or (d) an intentional violation of criminal law. Indemnification in accordance with this article shall be upon such terms and provisions as set forth in the bylaws of this corporation, as the same may be amended from time to time, and subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the Mississippi Business Corporation Act, codified at §79-4-1.01 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, and as the same now exist and are in effect on the effective date of these articles, particularly §§79-4-8.50 to 79-4-8.59 thereof.
