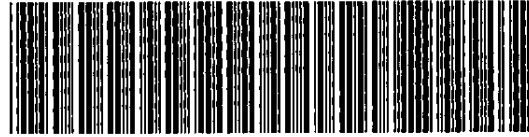

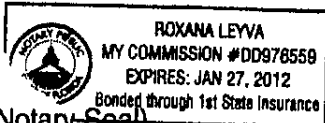

# Course Preference

New Student Course Preference is a process that allows incoming freshmen to notify their school/college of courses they are interested in taking during their first semester at the University of Miami. This process helps avoid long lines during orientation and is one less thing you have to worry about during fall orientation.

## **How does this process work?**

Students who submit their enrollment deposit on or before May 1st will be notified to login to their myUM account, where they will confirm their degree information; your major may also be changed at this time. Once you have confirmed your major, you will be able to review course information and then select courses you would prefer to take during the fall semester.

The information and courses provided will be specific to your degree program and major. Academic advisors will review your request and construct the best schedule for you based on your preferences. During freshman orientation in August, you will receive your fall schedule and have an opportunity to discuss your schedule with an academic advisor.

## **How do I factor in dual enrollment college credits, Advanced Placement (AP) and/or International Baccalaureate (IB) credits I've earned?**

Students are encouraged to submit official college transcripts, AP and/or IB exam results as soon as possible so that these credits may be evaluated for transferable UM credits. If you have recently taken an AP or IB exam, please indicate the specific subjects in the Comments section at the end of the process. Please speak with your advisor if your transferable credits do not appear to be factored into the course schedule you receive in August.

## **What is a credit? How many credits should I take?**

A credit is equivalent to a semester hour, and each semester hour is equivalent to 50 minutes of class per week for 15 weeks. Typically, courses are worth three credits. These courses meet either on Monday, Wednesday and Friday for 50 minutes a day or on Tuesday and Thursday for 75 minutes. Lab classes and special seminars may follow a different time frame. To maintain full-time status at the University of Miami, you must enroll in at least 12 credits per semester. Graduation requires a minimum of 120 credits while fulfilling degree requirements. A student graduating in four years averages 15 credits a semester.
