ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
SAINT ANDREW'S EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN

The undersigned hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming and becoming a body corporate, not for profit, under the laws of the State of Florida, under and by virtue of the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be SAINT ANDREW'S EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, and it is to be located in or about Homestead, Florida.

ARTICLE II

(1) The general nature and the object shall be a religious society for the support of the public worship of Almighty God, and for the purpose of developing and spreading the Christian faith according to the faith and discipline of the United Lutheran Church in America.

(2) That this corporation and all members who may become members of this Church and of this corporation recognize and adopt the constitution, canons, doctrines, discipline and worship of the United Lutheran Church in America, and the management of this corporation shall have the right to call pastors and to employ such other employees as they deem advisable.

(3) To print and circulate books, periodicals, magazines, papers, circulars and any and all kind of literature as the management of this corporation deems advisable.

(4) To buy, own, hold, control, work, develop, improve, pledge, mortgage, lease, sell, convey and otherwise acquire, deal in and dispose of real estate or any right, interest or estate therein and to erect churches and Sunday Schools and such other buildings or facilities as are not inconsistent with the purposes of this corporation

or the doctrines and principals of the Lutheran Church, and that any and all profits and income derived by this corporation shall be for the primary purpose of propagation of the Christian religion.

(5) All members of this Church shall be members of this corporation who shall elect annually at a meeting of the corporation called for that purpose by the Church Council; any number of the Active Members shall constitute a quorum for the holding of said meeting.

ARTICLE III

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V

(1) The affairs of this corporation are to be managed and directed by the Church Council, being 10 in number and composed of 9 Deacons and the Pastor; who shall, by virtue of his pastorship be a member of the Church Council as is provided by the constitution.

(2) The members of the Church Council shall be elected at an annual meeting called for such purpose and their term of office shall be provided for in the constitution of the congregation.

ARTICLE VI

Although the Financial Secretary might not be a member of the Council, he is included in the management of the affairs of the congregation.

ARTICLE VII

The By-Laws of the corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded by the congregation as provided in the By-Laws and/or the Constitution of the congregation.

ARTICLE VIII

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may at any time subject itself is Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000.00) Dollars, which indebtedness, however, shall never be greater than two-thirds (2/3) of the value of the property of the corporation.


