

In pursuance of the foregoing purposes, the Corporation shall have the power to develop and to provide extremely low income, very low income, low income and moderate income persons, elderly persons, and/or handicapped persons with housing facilities and services specially designed to meet their physical, social, and psychological needs, and to promote their health, security, happiness, and usefulness in longer living. 
