I am General Counsel for Eastern Foods Inc. ("Eastern"). I received a letter dated April 5, 2002 from Mr. Buck Kohr in which he rejected Eastern's Application for Authorization to Transact Business in Florida (please see attached copy). Mr. Kohr in his facsimile to me stated that in his absence you could be of assistance.

In that letter, it was stated that the amount due the State of Florida (pursuant to Florida Statutes 607.1502(4), 617.1502(4), 608.502(4)) to "cover annual report/uniform business report and penalty fees is \$29,216.25".

As I explained on the telephone to Mr. Kohr, I am trying to determine exactly what the situation is concerning this matter and why it has not been addressed here at Eastern. Quite frankly, we were somewhat surprised that Eastern is not registered. Eastern has a registration for state sales taxes and has been filing and paying franchise, excise taxes and personal property taxes for many years.

As you can see, Eastern has not been engaged in an attempt to hide from the State of Florida. Be that as it may, I need your assistance so that we can get this matter settled as soon as possible. First of all, I have been unable to reconcile the \$29,216.25 amount to any of the Florida Statutory fees or amounts. Can you please provide me with a breakdown of how that number was determined on a year by year basis?

If you can help us by providing this information for me, it will greatly facilitate an expeditious conclusion to this matter. If you have any questions about this situation or my request, please give me a call. Eastern Foods prides itself in being a good citizen in all of the jurisdictions in which we operate, and I want to continue that reputation in Florida.

Dear Mr. Kohr:

Thank you for your letter of April 15, 2002. The information that you provided concerning how the penalties and fees would be assessed was of great value in trying to arrive at a mutually agreeable resolution. Eastern Foods, Inc. ("Eastern") is eager to settle this matter and put it behind us. All of the parties that I have spoken to here admit that it was an error in not being registered, but not an intentional one. Eastern has not been hiding its existence in Florida, and has in fact been paying taxes, license fees and other fees for some time. I have attached copies of representative samples for your consideration (See Tab 2 attached).

As I am sure that you realize, the penalties and fees that you cite of \$29,216.25 are quite a substantial amount. Based on my analysis of the Florida statutes, I do not believe that Eastern owes quite that much. Therefore, I would like to make an offer to settle this matter today. I have hopefully included my understanding of the Florida law and an explanation that will be clear as to how we arrived at the amount being offered. If our offer is acceptable, then I can have the check in your hands within a week.

I agree that the statute you cite in your letter (Chapter 607.1502(4)<sup>1</sup> is the appropriate one to consider for the penalties that you have indicated. However, the statute calls for a range from \$500 to \$1,000. I would respectfully request that the lower number of \$500 be used in your calculations, since Eastern has not been intentionally hiding their existence (see attached copies).

I also note that you assessed fees and penalties back to 1975. After doing some research on my own, it is my understanding that there is a four year statute of limitations on the collection of statutory fees and penalties (See Florida Statute Chapter 95.011, 95.11(3)(f) and (n)<sup>2</sup>). Therefore as I understand it, you can only go back to 1998. I have endeavored to set out the appropriate numbers on the attached spreadsheet for reference.

Manufacturing and General Office 1000 Naturally Fresh Blvd. Atlanta, Ga. 30349 (404) 765-9000 Based on the calculations that I have done going back to 1998 and using the lower penalty of \$500, I have arrived at a sum of \$2,750.00 due and payable (see attached spreadsheet). If this amount is acceptable, I can have a check to you right away. If I have erred in my calculations or research please let me know.

I hope that this will allow us to bring a conclusion to this matter.

(4) A foreign corporation which transacts business in this state without authority to do so shall be liable to this state for the years or parts thereof during which it transacted business in this state without authority in an amount equal to all fees and taxes which would have been imposed by this act upon such corporation had it duly applied for and received authority to transact business in this state as required by this act. In addition to the payments thus prescribed, such corporation shall be liable for a civil penalty of not less than \$500 or more than \$1,000 for each year or part thereof during which it transacts business in this state without a certificate of authority. The Department of State may collect all penalties due under this subsection and may bring an action in circuit court to recover all penalties and fees due and owing the state.

#### 2. TITLE VIII LIMITATIONS

#### CHAPTER 95 LIMITATIONS OF ACTIONS; ADVERSE POSSESSION

#### § 95.011 Applicability.

A civil action or proceeding, called ``action" in this chapter, including one brought by the state, a public officer, a political subdivision of the state, a municipality, a public corporation or body corporate, or any agency or officer of any of them, or any other governmental authority, shall be barred unless begun within the time prescribed in this chapter or, if a different time is prescribed elsewhere in these statutes, within the time prescribed elsewhere. [emphasis added]

#### § 95.11 Limitations other than for the recovery of real property.

Actions other than for recovery of real property shall be commenced as follows:

- (3) WITHIN FOUR YEARS.-
- (f) An action founded on a statutory liability.
- (n) An action for a statutory penalty or forfeiture.



COMMENTS: This communication is further to our recent conversation regarding annual report fees and statutory penalties which would be assessed against Eastern Foods, Inc., under section 607.1502(4), Florida Statutes.

An application filed with the Division of Corporations indicates Eastern Foods, Inc. has transacted business in Florida since 1970. Accordingly, an amount of \$29,316.25 is due, reflecting statutory penalties of \$27,000.00, annual report fees of \$2,216.25, plus estimated charter taxes of \$100.00 for the period 1975-1987 (Mr. Kohr omitted this tax, repealed in 1987 from the calculations discussed in his April 15, 2002). As we discussed, the Department prefers to avoid litigation where possible and we

would, however, offer to settle the issue of foreign non-qualified penalties and annual report fees from Eastern Foods, Inc., for the sum of \$15,876.25, reflecting penalties from 1975 of \$13,500.00 assessed at the statutory minimum of \$500.00 per year. This offer remains in effect only until June 14, 2002.

A word about your client's alleged statute of limitations defense. It is not available in the case of an ongoing regulatory violation. See, e.g., Department of Environmental Protection v. Fleet Credit Corporation, 691 So.2d 512 (Fla. 4<sup>th</sup> DCA 1997). Further, because section 607.1502(4), Florida Statutes, mandates the collection of all fees, penalties and taxes due, without limitation, I seriously doubt a court would find the statute of limitations to be applicable. I should add I have handled litigation for the Division of Corporations since 1996.

Upon receipt of a check in the amount of \$15,876.25 payable to the Department of State, Division of Corporations, I will instruct the Division of Corporations to issue, Inc., a Certificate of Authority to transact business in Florida. Dear Mr. York:

I have reviewed your letter of April 26, 2002 and have discussed this matter with the management for my client, Eastern Foods, Inc. ("Eastern"). I have also read the case that you cited in support of your argument that the statute of limitations does not apply (Department of Environmental Protection v. Fleet Credit Corporation, 691 So.2d 512, Fla. 4<sup>th</sup> DCA 1997). I feel that your citation of the Fleet Credit case is not on point with the issues in this matter, as that case turns on the narrow exception to the limitations period found in environmental cases, where the statutes violated are "remedial in nature and intended to clean up abandoned, inactive waste disposal sites in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare." 691 So.2d at 513. In the case of a repeated tort, it is fairly established law that there is liability only for actions accruing during the limitations period, unless there is some sort of attempt to conceal the tort. See, e.g., 35 Fla. Jur. 2d "Limitations and Laches," s. 62. In our situation, of course, there was no tort at all, nor is there anything to remediate. Instead, what we have was an inadvertent failure to register. It seems clear that the four-year statute of limitations should apply.

We continue to believe that \$2,750.00 would be a very reasonable settlement in this matter, particularly as Eastern brought this matter to your attention and the Department was not put to any investigatory expense. Nevertheless, in the interest of resolving this matter, I am authorized to offer \$4,216.25, which sum is the total of <u>all</u> of the annual report fees (\$2,216.25), plus \$2,000.00 in fines (\$500 per year for four years).

This resolution would allow the Department to recoup an amount considerably in excess of the amount which Eastern would have paid during the period it failed to register, and resolve the matter for the future.

On behalf of Eastern Foods, I hope that you can accept this offer in compromise and allow us to close this matter without referring it to outside counsel.
