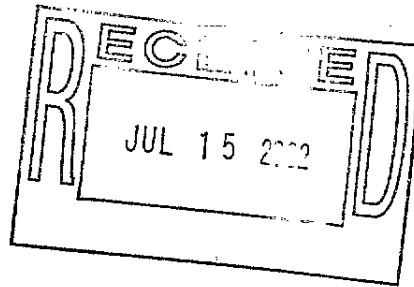

Upon receipt of a check in that amount payable to the Department of State, Division of Corporations, I will instruct the Division of Corporations to issue Teksult, Inc. a

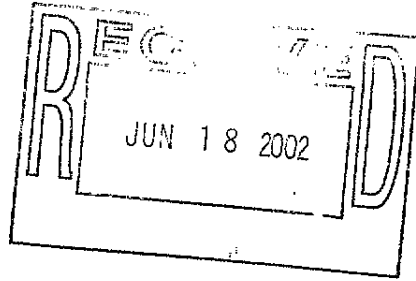

Dear Sir/Madam,

This letter is a petition and plea for a waiver and abatement of \$1150.00 in penalty fees assessed against my corporation by the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, please. The fees are for lateness in registering my business as a foreign corporation in the State of Florida.

My business is a one-person close corporation incorporated in the State of Wisconsin since 1998. When I moved my family to Florida in February 2001 and began to do business here (writing computer programs) I did not know about the requirement to register with the State. The income from my business is quite meager and I cannot afford to hire attorneys and accountants so I do all of the bookkeeping and record keeping myself. I try very hard to do a good, conscientious job of meeting all of the legal requirements but no one ever even hinted to me that I was required to register and file a Florida annual report/uniform business report. As soon as I was made aware of the law I complied immediately (March 2002).

I had enclosed a letter with my application acknowledging that my application was late and pleading that any penalty be waived. I explained that a penalty fee, especially a large one, would be devastating and could drive me out of business. However, in spite of the letter, a penalty fee of \$1150.00 was assessed anyway.

It was suggested to me by the Division of Corporations that my only possible recourse at this stage would be to write to the General Counsel of the Department of State. So I am writing to ask you to please be merciful and look leniently upon my situation. I wish that I had a more substantial reason for being late but the truth is that I just plain didn't know about the requirement.

I'm very sorry. Please help me.
