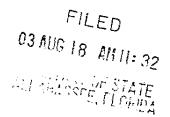

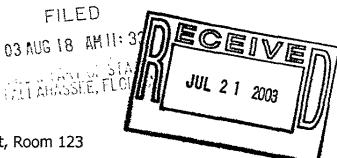

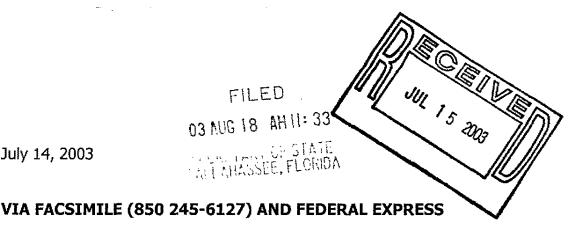

Dear Ms. Torres,

As we discussed on the telephone on June 30, 2003, Professional Bull Riders, Inc. ("PBR") requested that the Application By Foreign Corporation For Authorization To Transact Business In Florida ("Application") filed by PBR with the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, on or about April 4, 2003 be withdrawn and the filing fee in the amount of \$78.75 refunded. A copy of the Application as originally filed is attached for your reference. By this letter, I am again requesting such withdrawal and refund. As we discussed, the basis for our requests is that PBR was not "doing business" in the State of Florida during the periods indicated on the Application.

The Application indicated that PBR first transacted business in the State of Florida in 1998. That statement was made because 1998 was the first year in which PBR staged a bull riding event in the state. The 1998 event took place in Tampa, Florida on February 23 and 24, 1998, and PBR staged no other events in the State of Florida that year. PBR had never staged bull riding events in Florida prior to that event and never made or evidenced any plan or intent to stage any subsequent events in Florida. PBR made no multi-year contracts or other commitments with regard to staging events in Florida in 1998 or thereafter. The 1998 event was truly an "isolated event", was completed within 30 days and was not in the course of repeated transactions of a like nature. Under Fla. Stat. Ann. Section 607.1501(2)(j), Professional Bull Riders, Inc. did not transact business in the State of Florida in 1998 and, correspondingly, had no statutory duty to file an Application For Authorization To Transact Business In Florida.

In 1999 and in each year thereafter, Professional Bull Riders, Inc. made the isolated and independent decision whether to conduct a

professional bull riding event in the state of Florida. Again, PBR had no duty or obligation to conduct any events in the State in any year and at no time did PBR enter into any multiyear contracts or other business arrangements requiring that it stage events on a continuing or repeated basis in the State of Florida. At no time did PBR's actions indicate a purpose or intent to continue conducting events in the State and each year the independent decision was made whether or not to conduct any events in the following year. Each of the events staged lasted no more than 2 days, took place at different times and were never in the course of repeated transactions of a like nature. Again, under Fla. Stat. Ann. Section 607.1501(2)(j), Professional Bull Riders, Inc. did not transact business in the State of Florida in 1999 or in any year thereafter and, correspondingly, PBR had no statutory duty to file an Application For Authorization To Transact Business In Florida.

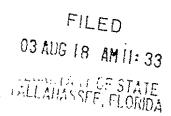
A review of the Florida case law revealed only one case relevant to these issues. That case is <u>Crockin v. Boston Store of Ft. Myers, Inc.</u>, 188 So. 853 (Florida 1939). In <u>Crockin</u>, the Florida Supreme Court held that the exchange of corporate stock in a Florida corporation to satisfy a debt did not constitute "doing business." *Id.* at 864. The court extensively quoted *Corpus Juris Secundum* for the proposition that an isolated transaction does not generally constitute doing business. *Id.* at 858-59. The current relevant CJS section states in part (Emphasis Added):

"Generally, single or isolated transactions do not constitute doing business within the state, although they are a part of the very business for which the corporation is organized to transact, if the action of the corporation in engaging therein indicates no purpose of continuity of conduct in that respect . . . Where the single or isolated transaction forms a part of the regular business of the corporation and the action of the corporation in engaging therein indicates a purpose to continue to engage within the state in the transaction or a part of all of its ordinary business, or where the transaction is of a nature which necessitates a continuity of activity by the corporation within the state for a considerable period of time, the foreign corporation is doing, transacting, carrying on, or engaging in business therein within the meaning of the statutes."

CJS corporations § 908 (2002).

The relevant CJS section goes on to state:

"The determination of whether a transaction is isolated is largely one of fact to be made on a case-by-case basis; reasonableness is the touchstone. If the activities of a foreign corporation are extensive in scope and involve a great deal of work over a period of time, the corporation may be doing business in the state even though all such activities are related to a single contract."

In this case, applying a reasonableness standard, the facts do not support the conclusion that PBR was doing business in the State of Florida in 1998 or in any subsequent year. PBR's activities in the State were not, by any definition, extensive in scope, did not involve a great deal of work over a period of time, did not indicate a purpose to continue to engage in such transactions in the future, and were not of a nature which necessitated a continuity of activity for a considerable time.

Finally, it is noted that Fla. Stat. Ann. Section 607.1501(3) states: "The list of activities in subsection 2 [i.e., activities that do not constitute transacting business] is not exhaustive." Given the limited contact PBR has had with the State of Florida, the limited period of time in which PBR has engaged in activities in the State of Florida, the absence of any indication or obligation by PBR to engage in continuing activities in the State of Florida and the isolated nature of PBR's activities in the State of Florida, it is clear that PBR has not transacted business in the State sufficient to trigger the statutory duty to file an Application By Foreign Corporation For Authorization To Transact Business In Florida.

For the foregoing reasons, PBR again requests that the Application By Foreign Corporation For Authorization To Transact Business In Florida filed by PBR on or about April 4, 2003 be withdrawn and the filing fee in the amount of \$78.75 refunded.

As you know, on June 30, 2003 you granted PBR an extension of time within which to respond to Mr. Gerard T. York's offer to settle the issue of annual report fees and penalties to July 18, 2003. As a result, I would appreciate your immediate review and consideration of PBR's position and your providing me a response and decision prior to that date so that PBR may timely consider Mr. York's offer in light of your decision. If you are unable to provide a response to our position before that date, I hereby request a short extension of time to enable us to work through the issues.

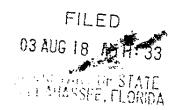
