

----- SECOND: In order to perform the mission entrusted to him, the attorney shall be empowered to open and close bank current, deposit and credit or savings accounts in local or foreign currency; draw, overdraw and issue charge orders on current accounts by means of cybernetic or telephone procedures; draw, deposit, endorse, cash, revalidate, cancel, issue stop payment orders and have protested checks and other at sight documents; withdraw checkbooks, request, approve and object balances; authorize charges in current account, open and close savings, at sight or term accounts and make deposits, withdrawals or drafts on the same.
