AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CAH PROPERTIES, INC.

CAH PROPERTIES, INC., a Florida Profit Corporation (the "Corporation") organized and existing under and by virtue of the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "Act").

The Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation were filed with the Secretary of State of Florida on December 10, 1980, as Document No. F08466.

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, which supersede the original Articles of Incorporation, and all amendments to them, were adopted by the shareholders of the Corporation and the number of votes cast was sufficient for approval. To effect the foregoing, the text of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby restated and amended as herein set forth in full:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is CAH PROPERTIES, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The Corporation's principal office address is 2102 N. Park Road, Plant City, Florida 33562, and the mailing address of the Corporation is P.O. Box 4442, Plant City, Florida 33563.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of Florida.

ARTICLE IV CAPITAL STOCK

The total number of authorized capital stock of the Corporation shall be seven thousand five hundred (7,500) shares of voting common stock having a par value of \$1.00 (the "Shares").

ARTICLE V BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation may, to the full extent permitted by Florida Law, indemnify any person who is or was an employee or agent of the Corporation or was serving at the request of the Corporation as an employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise.

ARTICLE VIII LIABILITY FOR MONETARY DAMAGES

No director of the Corporation shall be personally liable to the Corporation or any other person for monetary damages for any statement, vote, decision or failure to act regarding corporate management or policy by such director as a director, except for liability under the Act and other applicable law. If the Act is amended to authorize corporate action further eliminating or limiting the personal liability of directors, then the liability of a director of the Corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by the Act as so amended.
