**Certificate of Incorporation  
of  
Interfaith Community Service based on Faith in Action**

(Under article 10 of the Religious Corporation Law) - We the undersigned, all being of full age, of whom at least two thirds are citizens of the United States of America, and at least one a resident of the State of New York, for the purpose of incorporating an unincorporated Church pursuant to article 10 of the Religious corporation law hereby do certify as follows:

First - a meeting of Interfaith Community Service based on Faith in Action (herein referred to as the said organization) an unincorporated nonprofit religious organization was duly called and held in conformity with the aforesaid article 10 of the religious corporation law on June 27 2005 at 75 East 3rd Street apt. BB New York, New York 10003 At that meeting a majority of the duly qualified voters of said corporation being at least six in number were present or by proxy duly authorized in writing.

Second - At said meeting, one of the subscribers hereto, Brother Alfred Tarantino was presiding Officer and the others, Wu Yi Fang and Ronald Nay subscribers hereto were inspectors of the election

Third - For the purpose of better administration, supervision and governance of those particular churches incorporated under the relevant sections of the Religious Corporation Law of the USA and the same said churches that have agreed to abide by the rules and conditions set forth by the said Organization and professing the same faith, at said meeting, it was duly decided that the said Organization should be incorporated.

Fourth - The Name of the proposed Corporation as decided on at the said meeting is to be to be known as: Interfaith Community Service based on Faith in Action.

Fifth - the purpose of which the Corporation is formed is described in the articles that follow:

To organize, form and establish a church (that is not just a building) but a fellowship of persons gathered into a community with the common goals of praying to the Supreme Lord, worshipping Our Lord and serving the Will of the Supreme Lord together; To endeavor sincerely and to the very best of our God-given abilities to please the Lord with our thoughts words and deeds with all our hearts and all our strength so that our natural Love of God might grow and become increasingly manifest in purity and so we might,

#7 By supporting the preparation and distribution of meals lovingly offered to the Lord and distributing those meals in restaurants or in programs that freely feed the homeless people. #8 By financially supporting youth groups that organize community service projects for young people to participate in. These said youth groups (like other existing Big Brother and Big Sister programs ) may thus organize sports programs, field trips, education programs etc to facilitate young people's association with spiritually mature adults (who may have a positive influence on their religious character

development).

Tenth - Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes: religious, charitable and educational as specified in Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue code of 1986

or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Eleventh - No part of the income of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of the corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes) and no member trustee or officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the dissolution of the corporation. In the event of dissolution all of the remaining assets and property of the corporation shall, after payment of necessary expenses, thereof be distributed to another organization exempt under section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal Tax laws, or to the Federal Government or the State or local government for a public purpose.

Twelfth - No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation or participating in, or intervening in (including public distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidates for public office.

Thirteenth - The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

Fourteenth - That all the subscribers of the within certificate are of full age, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of New York
