Since 2005 HigherSchool has provided students with a blended program of supplemental DA instruction in Reading, Language Arts, and Math. We have worked with students from PreK up to grade 12. This blended program combines an individualized, online program with an instructor led group of no more than 10 students. Both components are research-based and were designed to reinforce each other with the common goal of student improvement.

First students receive an initial assessment (pretest) to determine actual grade level understanding as defined by state standards and to identify specific skill gaps in Reading and Math. These results are automatically scored, then measured against relevant state standards and sub-standards by grade. Based on the outcome, students are then assigned lesson modules designed to explain the core idea in a readily understandable format. As a student completes each lesson module a series of questions are provided to insure the students has a thorough understanding of the lesson. If the student fails to achieve a score of 80% or better then they must complete a similar module focused around the same concept but with a more indepth explanation. This process continues until the student masters the lesson, as determined by the score attained at the conclusion of the lesson, or we identify this student as in need of additional remediation with the on-site instructor.

Student instruction is usually divided equally between online and instructor-led groups. The online portion of the blended program insures that student instruction is differentiated by ability allowing each student to progress at their own pace, while group instruction will reinforce the online portion with the use of workbooks and manipulatives. The group will also work collaboratively to work through problems

The assessments (pre and post), the online curriculum, and the print materials originate from the same content provider to insure synergy exists throughout the instructional program, that all curriculum is aligned to state standards and that instruction is reinforced throughout. This instructional strategy has allowed us to create the most effective supplemental instructional program in each jurisdiction in which we provide service.

Though the following eight strategies were developed with schools in mind we intend to implement them during our expanded learning program for low achieving and low performing students

- 1. Making every minute count or maximizing added time;
- 2. Prioritizing increased hours that are tailored to the school and their students;
