## DOMESTIC CORPORATION AND FOREIGN CORPORATION

## ARTICLES OF MERGER

The undersigned corporations, pursuant to Section 607.1107 of the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby execute the following Articles of Merger:

FIRST: The names of the corporations proposing to merge and the names of the states or countries under the laws of which such corporations are organized are as follows:

**SECOND:** The laws of the state or country under which such foreign corporation is organized permit such merger and such foreign corporation is complying with those laws in effecting the merger.

**THIRD:** The plan of merger is as follows:

1. The name of each constituent corporation and its corporation identification number (CID) is:

2. The name of the surviving corporation and its corporation identification number (CID) is:

3. For each constituent corporation, the number of issued and outstanding shares of common stock, all of which are of one class and are voting shares, is as follows:

Info America Phone Books/Florida, Inc.

80 Common shares

Talking Directories, Inc.

60,000 Common shares

The number of shares of neither constituent corporation is subject to change prior to the effective date of the merger.

4. The terms and conditions of the proposed merger, including the manner and basis of converting the shares of each constituent corporation into shares of the surviving corporation, or into cash or other consideration, are as follows:

The capital stock of Info America Phone Books/Florida, Inc. shall be completely cancelled and the current shareholders of Talking Directories, Inc. shall be the shareholders of the surviving corporation.

5. The Articles of Incorporation of the surviving corporation shall not be amended or restated by virtue of the merger. The Articles of Incorporation of Talking Directories, Inc. shall be the Articles of Incorporation of the surviving corporation.

**FIFTH:** The effective date of the certificate of merger shall be the 31st day of December, 1997.
