To Whom It May Concern

This letter is written to explain the circumstances surrounding my company's loss of corporate status. I am eager to reinstate my corporation with the Department of Corporations, but hope to mitigate some portion of the cost by showing that this circumstance is not an attempt on my part to avoid paying the fee..

My corporation's year end is June 30, a feature which has created confusion for both me and my bookkeepers over the years. My original accountant recommended that timing for reasons that I did not, and do not, understand. The difficulties of managing a mid-year fiscal year-end have been several:

\*\* It has confused the bookkeepers and tax preparers I have employed. Realization that the Corporate return is due to the state of Florida and to the IRS has usually come at the last moment. Although we have managed to submit those returns, the corporate report fee has gotten lost in the shuffle.

\*\* I have no record of receiving the corporate report form from the Department of Corporations. This is not an excuse for not paying the fee, but I'm certain that most businesses pay when they receive the form. I would ask that you investigate whether the form has been sent to me over the years. Perhaps there is confusion in your department about when my year-end occurs. **Please respond to this inquiry.**

In any event, I hope to expedite reinstatement as soon as possible. I will submit my corporate tax return, due to the IRS Sept. 15 and to you by the end of September. Enclosed is a check for back fees.
