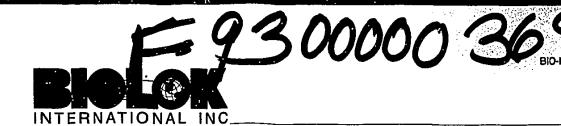

MERGER

91 MPR 11 PH 2: 23 Pursuant to the provisions of sections 607.1101 through 607.1107 and specifically 607.1104. Florida Statutes, this Florida for profit corporation was merged into:

Bio-Lok International Inc., a Delaware Corporation (Florida Doc. # F93000003694)

The Articles and Plan of Merger of Minimatic into Bio-Lok are as follows:

ARTICLE I

The Board of Directors of both corporations have adopted and approved the plan of merger of the subsidiary (Minimatic Implant Technology, Inc.) into its parent (Bio-Lok International Inc.) effective March 1, 1997. To this extent, the Constituent Corporations hereby agree that the Merging Corporation shall be merged with and into the Surviving Corporation, and the Merging Corporation and the Surviving Corporation shall be a single corporation. The Surviving Corporation shall be the corporation continuing after the merger, and the separate existence of the Merging Corporation shall cease on the Effective Date aforementioned.

ARTICLE II

The merger was effected by the shares of the outstanding capital stock of the Merging Corporation, owned by the Surviving Corporation, being surrendered and canceled on the Effective Date. No additional shares need be issued by the Surviving Corporation to reflect the ownership interest of the stockholder after the effective date. The then outstanding shares of the Surviving Corporation shall be unaffected by the merger and shall continue to constitute all of the outstanding stock in the Surviving Corporation.

ARTICLE III

The surviving corporation is Bio-Lok International Inc., a Delaware Corporation, located at 312 S. Military Trail, Deerfield Beach, Florida 33442 (Florida Doc. # F93000003694).

ARTICLE IV

Pursuant to 607.1104, Merger of subsidiary corporation, Florida Statutes, this merger does not require the approval of the shareholder of the Surviving Corporation or the Merging Corporation. Notwithstanding, the shareholders of both the Surviving Corporation and the Merging Corporation have approved this merger in its annual meeting dated June 25, 1996. The conditions of the statutes of the State of Florida have been complied with as follows:

- (a) All of the outstanding shares of capital stock of the Merging Corporation were owned, and on the March 1, 1997 of this merger will be owned by the Surviving Corporation;
- (b) The Merger does not conflict with or make any changes in the Articles of Incorporation or the By-Laws of the Surviving Corporation;
- (c) Since all the shares of the Merging Corporation were owned by the Surviving Corporation, notice of the merger was not required.
