Dear Mr. Collins:

Thank you for sending the application to register as a foreign not-for-profit corporation in the State of Florida. I have made a good faith effort to fulfill all the requirements of the registration form, as well as what was mentioned in our conversation, and in subsequent conversations with various other offices of State Government. Included with the application herein are: a check for \$315, (representing the \$70 registration fee and the annual report fee of \$61.25 for the past four years); copies of the 990 for the past five years; a copy of my letter to the Office of the Lt. Governor of the Virgin Islands, requesting an original, currently dated "Letter of Good Standing"; a copy of our most recent "Letter of Good Standing" dated April 26, 1995. I do not know how long it will take for St. Thomas to respond. My information is that the island is still without power and my repeated telephone calls to that office have not been answered.

We believed that we had complied with all requirements of the Department of State under section 496, until 1989 when we were notified that the laws pertaining to that section had been repealed. We continue to register with the Department of Agriculture, as a charitable corporation, and the Department of Revenue. We were never notified that we were required to register with the Department of State under another section of Florida Statute. I have enclosed a copy of the letter from the Department of State that we received in 1989. If we were registered with your Department under one section of statute, but not another, why did you not notify us at that time so that we could have corrected the situation then?

This matter of non-registration came about because we applied for a small grant to help us educate teachers about the marine ecology of the Florida Keys - a very precious resource to the State of Florida. The \$4000 penalty which you have indicated must be paid before you can process the application for the Certificate of Authority is excessive, and seriously

impacts our operation. We are asking that we be granted the Certificate, so that we can proceed to sign the necessary contracts to receive the FACEE grant, and we will continue to seek abatement of the penalty through the General Counsel's office.

Our mission in the State of Florida is to teach people the absolute necessity of protecting our planet, specifically the marine environment. The bureaucratic processes should support these efforts, not hinder them.

We very much appreciate any assistance you can provide us in processing this application and in our efforts to have this penalty abated.

Marc, I am forwarding the above referenced application and last five federal income tax returns along with the corporation's letter requesting the DOS waive the civil penalties due for transacting business in Florida without authority. Please be aware that the Division of Corporations calculates the civil penalties and annual report fees due by foreign not for profit corporations from 1991 regardless if said corporations have transacted business prior to 1991 as the penalty provision (s. 617.1502(4), F.S.) went into effect in 1991 (see s. 95, ch. 90-179 laws of Florida). The referenced corporation has paid \$245.00 in annual report fees (\$61.25 each by 501(c)(3) IRC not for profit corporations for 1992 through 1995). The corporation is now requesting that the DOS waive \$4000 in civil penalties due for transacting business in Florida since 1979 (calculated as of 1991). Marcella J. D'Haem, business manager/treasurer for said corporation had called our office about information concerning qualifying. It was at that time that I informed her that the corporation was liable for these referenced Prior to submitting the application, I was contacted by personnel from both the Florida Department of Insurance and Florida Department of Environmental Protection concerning this matter. Apparently, said corporation had either written and/or called these departments concerning the civil penalties collected by the DOS.
