We have reviewed the Florida Statutes (1993) sent with your letter of June 27. We were quite surprised to receive this letter especially when it contained a request for several thousand dollars. It is as if Danjovic Inc. had suddenly come out of hiding which is simply not the case. Florida State tax returns have been filed continuously since 1985. How can it be that the company had never received a request to file this Application prior to 1993? Is the \$500 per annum a penalty for not filing or is it the annual fee for each year?

In any event, we believe Danjovic Inc. is exempt from the annual fee under Section 607.1501 2(f) of the Florida Statutes (1993). The company's sole shareholder, Daniel A. Thompson, is a Canadian citizen and resident who spends less than 90 days per annum in Florida. Danjovic owns five condominium townhouse/apartment units. These units are maintained by the condominium corporations which receive a monthly fee to cover maintenance costs. The units are rented to vacationers subject to approval by Mr. Thompson. Accordingly, the units are cared for by the Condominium Corporations but Mr. Thompson is the only person who can contract on behalf of the corporation.

Please advise us whether you require additional information in order to process our request for exemption under Section 607.1501 2(f).

Thank you for your letter dated August 12, 1994, concerning the "Application by Foreign Corporation for Authorization to Transact Business in Florida", submitted to this office by Danjovic Inc..

This office administers the "Florida Business Corporation Act", Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, which governs domestic and foreign corporations in Florida. The above referenced application that was submitted to this office by Danjovic Inc., states 1985 as the date first transacted business in Florida. Section 607.1501(1), F.S., authority of foreign corporation to transact business required, states that "a foreign corporation may not transact business in this state until it obtains a certificate of authority from the Department of State". This office is required by s. 607.1502(4), F.S., to collect the appropriate minimum civil penalty of \$500 for each year or part thereof that a foreign corporation transacts business in Florida without authority, along with the annual report fees that would have been paid had it qualified when it first transacted business.

Please be aware that this office had no prior knowledge that Danjovic Inc. was transacting business in Florida without authority until it received the application. The Division of Corporations exchanges information with the Florida Department of Revenue, pursuant to s. 213.053(14), F.S.. The information obtained from the Florida Department of Revenue relates to corporate taxpayers that are not on file or have a dissolved status with the Division of Corporations and which have filed tax returns pursuant to either Chapter 199 (intangible personal property taxes) or Chapter 220 (corporation income tax). In July of 1993, this office received data reflecting Danjovic's compliance with Florida's revenue laws. On November 24, 1993, this office wrote Danjovic Inc. inquiring as to whether it needed a certificate of authority to transact business in Florida within the meaning of s. 607.1501, F.S.. This office then received the "Application by Foreign Corporation for Authorization to Transact Business in Florida", for Danjovic Inc., reflecting 1985 as the date first transacted business in Florida.

Ultimately, it is the responsibility of each foreign corporation to be aware of the laws that govern it and to obtain proper authority prior to conducting business when its activities constitute the transaction of business. Florida is not unique in requiring foreign corporations to obtain authority to transact business, as every state in the United States requires a foreign corporation to receive authority prior to transacting business. It is not the responsibility of this office to locate and notify corporations of their filing obligation.

Regarding your belief that Danjovic Inc. is exempt from receiving authority under s. 607.1501(2)(f), F.S., please note that this section refers to the interstate commerce nature of "soliciting or obtaining orders". Danjovic Inc. does not solicit or obtain orders for goods or merchandise in the State of Florida. Rather, Danjovic Inc. owns and rents five condominium units in Florida. The rental of condominium units clearly falls outside the scope of s. 607.1501(2)(f), F.S.. Further, Danjovic's activity of renting condominium units in Florida is considered "transacting business" as it exceeds the provision set forth in s. 607.1501(2)(m), F.S., "owning, without more, real or personal property".

Please be advised that Danjovie's business activity in Florida is considered by this office to constitute the transaction of business. Therefore, Danjovic Inc. is liable for \$5301.25 in civil penalties and annual report fees. This office respectfully requests that Danjovic Inc. remit the fees due this office to avoid the necessity of further action. This office will then process the application and grant Danjovic Inc. a certificate of authority to transact business in Florida.

Re: Danjovic Inc. Ref. No. W94000009582

I have been retained by Danjovic, Inc. regarding the proposed assessment of the civil penalty on the corporation for transacting business without authority.

We submit that the corporation should not be assessed with the penalty as it had not transacted business in Florida during the subject years within the meaning of the statute. Even though Section 607.1501(2) describes certain situations in which a corporation is deemed to not transact business in the State of Florida and which does not specifically include the activities carried on by Danjovic, Inc., this section is not all inclusive. Subsection (2) provides that "(t)he following activities, *among others*, do not constitute transacting business within the meaning of section 1". Subsection (3) also states that the list in subsection (2) is not exhaustive.

In Danjovic Inc.'s situation, the activities carried on by the corporation related to the rental of the condominium units were all carried on in Canada. All leases were negotiated and accepted in Canada and the corporation never engaged in the management of the rental of the units. It merely collected the rent after payment of the management fees. These activities are definitely similar in substance to the types of activities illustrated by subsection (2) and should be availed of the exemption.
