Dear Mr. Dasenbrook:

It has been brought to my attention that the above mentioned entity may be transacting business in the State of Florida. I have searched the records of this office and have found no record of any filing for Greyhounds, Inc. d/b/a Dasenbrook Kennel, a corporation organized under the laws of Oregon.

Section 607.1501, Florida Statutes (copy enclosed), states that a foreign corporation may not transact business in this State without obtaining a certificate of authority from the Florida Department of State. If after reviewing s. 607.1501(2), F.S., it is determined that said corporation does not need to obtain authority, please provide a written response to that effect within thirty (30) days to avoid the necessity of further action.

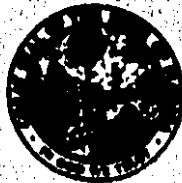
