
Dear Ms. Head:

Dear Mr. Dickinson:

We are in receipt of your letter dated January 18, 1996 (copy attached) regarding our client, International Post Tension, and their qualification in Florida. As requested, we have enclosed a check in the amount of \$200 to cover the required annual report fee.

IPT did begin conducting business in Florida on November 1, 1995. However, the filing of the paperwork was delayed due to circumstances beyond our client's control. Our client experienced a delay as a result of having to send the qualification application to the registered agent's office for signature. Additional delays resulted as personnel were off work and offices were closed over the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays. Add to this the fact that IPT began business in Florida so late in the calendar year, that even the delay of a couple of weeks meant the difference between being "qualified" in 1996 rather than 1995. If the company had begun business earlier in the year and experienced the same delays as mentioned above, they would not have run into the problem that presented itself at year end. Rather, the company would have ended up being "qualified" in the same year that it began business and the civil penalty would not have been an issue. Therefore, with the above circumstances in mind, we respectfully request an abatement of the \$1,000 civil penalty.





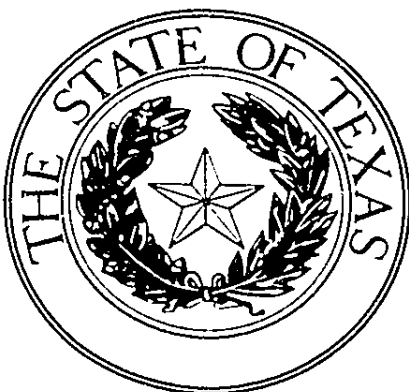
