Dear Sir or Madam:

In reference to the above corporation, today, I called your information line and spoke with Mr. Andy Dunlap. After explaining our situation to Mr. Dunlap, he suggested that I submit the enclosed reinstatement application to you with a check for \$150.00 and request that you consider reinstatement and waive the \$600.00 reinstatement fee. Mr. Dunlap also suggested that I set forth in writing why the annual report was not filed timely.

Please be advised that my office is general counsel to the principals of Choice Leasing Corp. In February 1997 our service company, Corporation Service Company (CSC Networks, Inc.), filed a new corporation for our client, Choice Leasing Corp., in the State of Delaware and thereafter registered the corporation to do business in New Jersey and Florida. All of the appropriate forms were filed and Corporation Service Company (CSC) became the registered agents for the Corps in both Delaware and Florida and the undersigned became the registered agent for the Corp in New Jersey. Since that time, this office as registered agent for the New Jersey filing purposes, received and filed the annual report for 1998 for the corporation. However, at no time did we receive any annual report filing for the State of Florida. Since, in New Jersey the annual reports are mailed directly to the registered agent for processing and/or forwarding to the client for handling, I assumed that the procedure was the same in Florida, and that CSC as the registered agent, had received and processed the annual report. Unfortunately, I learned today that this is not the procedure in Florida.

Yesterday, quite by accident my secretary was standing in our reception room speaking with one of my client's when a secretary from another office in the building came into the reception area trying to catch the mailman who had delivered mail to the wrong address. My secretary overheard them talking and recognized the name "Choice Leasing". Thus, we received your "application for reinstatement".

This was the first time it had come to our attention that there were any problems with the annual report filing. We immediately called our registered agent to find out why they did not forward the annual report filing to us for processing, only to learn that in the State of Florida

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annual reports are mailed directly to the company and not to the registered agent (which is the case in New Jersey).

This office never received the annual report filing for this corporation to submit same for timely filing, and at this juncture, can only assume that, if in fact, it was delivered for timely filing, the individual who may have received it either returned it to the post office as unknown, or destroyed it without attempting to see if it belonged to anyone in the building.

Additionally, only when we received the "notice" yesterday did we realize that when CSC filed using our address in New Jersey, they failed to put a c/o to insure proper delivery of all documents.

We have completed the reinstatement form and corrected the mailing address information to avoid any further problems of this nature in the future.

On the basis of the above it would be greatly appreciated if you would consider this matter for reinstatement and waive the reinstatement fee.

Thank you for your anticipated cooperation.
