

Regarding the \$7,000 penalty for having failed to register with the Department of State, we regret that we did so, but, unfortunately, were never advised that we were required to. We have registered as a charitable organization with the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumers Service and as far as we knew, had complied with all state requirements. (ARMDI is the U.S. support arm of Magen David Adom, Israel's emergency medical/disaster/ambulance/blood/healthcare network.)

Also, because we are a branch office of the National/New York headquarters of ARMDI, we assumed that their being incorporated in New York State automatically covered us.

Again, we apologize for any errors or omissions in the past, and are submitting the documentation you requested in the hope that we shall now be properly registered.
