This firm represents Professional Detailing Network, Inc. ("PDN"), a New Jersey corporation with offices located at 1009 Lenox Drive, Building IV, Suite 103, Lawrenceville, NJ 09648. The purpose of this letter is to request that the Department of State confirm that, given the limited nature of PDN's activities in the state, PDN is not required to file for a Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in the State of Florida. However, in the event that PDN is required to so qualify, we request that the Department of State waive or, in the alternative substantially reduce, the penalties that would otherwise be imposed because of PDN's failure to qualify in a timely manner. We are advised by the Office of the Secretary of State that the penalties are \$9376.25.

PDN was incorporated in 1987 and undertook to comply with the laws of the states in which it did business. PDN timely filed income tax returns, unemployment tax and other employee-related assessments. However, as PDN did not have significant resources during its start-up period, it did not consult counsel and was unaware that it might separately have to qualify to do business in Florida or other states. The situation has remained largely unchanged since 1990.

ACTIVITIES OF PDN IN FLORIDA

PDN engages in contractual promotional activities principally for drug companies. Through employees who may be residents of Florida, PDN calls on physicians and others in the medical field and delivers samples of pharmaceutical products ("samples") that are manufactured and sold by drug companies. Acting as an independent contractor, PDN distributes free samples on behalf of drug companies who pay PDN based on the time required to effect such deliveries and not with respect to any sales. Periodically, PDN's employees transmit to its service bureau in New Jersey, using the telephone or the Internet, reports of the calls completed and the

samples delivered. From its headquarters in New Jersey, PDN delivers reports and other information to the drug companies. All of PDN's activities, other than making calls and delivering samples, occur at its headquarters in New Jersey.

PDN does not manufacture products. PDN does not solicit or accept orders on behalf of drug companies. PDN does not fill orders or arrange for delivery of goods. PDN does not maintain an office and has no assets or bank accounts in Florida.

DISCUSSION

Given the limited nature of PDN's activities and the tenuous nexus between its activities and the State of Florida, we believe that PDN is not required to qualify to transact business in the state.

Section 607.1501 of the Florida 1989 Business Corporation Act provides, in part:

- (2) The following activities, among others, do not constitute transacting business within the meaning of subsection (1)
 - (e) Selling through independent contractors.
 - (f) Soliciting or obtaining orders, whether by mail or through employees, agents, or otherwise, if the orders require acceptance outside this state before they become contracts.
- (3) The list of activities in subsection (2) is not exhaustive.

Subsection (e) is apparently predicated on the assumption that independent contractors in the state will qualify to transact business in the state such that the qualification of an out-of-state drug company is not necessary to protect the state's interest in sales occurring within the state. Although PDN is an independent contractor to drug companies, its activities do not involve sales; its employees simply deliver samples of drugs to prescribers of the drugs. The drugs are later sold, if at all, through an independent sales distribution channel. PDN's promotional activities are more akin to activities of the out-of-state drug company that is exempt from qualifying to transact

business in the state under Subsection (e).

Subsection (f) exempts activities including solicitation where the order is accepted outside the state. While the delivery of samples to physicians in the state may generate interest in pharmaceutical products, PDN's activities fall short of soliciting or obtaining orders for out-of-state sales. Therefore, PDN plays a less significant role in the distribution of goods in the state than is exempted by Subsection (f).

PDN's activities are similar to, although less broad than, activities that are exempt from qualification under the foregoing exemptions. Given the expressed intent of Subsection (3) of Section 607.1501 to exempt such similar activities, we believe that PDN is not required to obtain a Certificate of Authority in order to conduct its business in Florida. We ask that you confirm this view to us.

In the event that PDN is required under the facts and circumstances set forth above to qualify, we submit that it would be inappropriate to subject PDN to penalties related to such limited activities in the past, particularly in view of the fact that PDN has acted in good faith and without intent to violate Florida law. If a penalty is unavoidable, we request that it be reduced to reflect the fact that the failure to qualify is due solely to inadvertence and not to any intentional malfeasance. PDN is voluntarily acting to qualify in Florida, if such qualification is necessary, having only recently been advised that it may be necessary.

In the event that PDN is required to file, in the interest of efficiency only, I have enclosed the Application for to Transact Business in the State of Florida together with the filing fee. If filing is not required, please return the forms to my attention. If the filing is required, we ask that the application be accepted without penalty or, in the alternative, that the penalty be reduced to take into account the circumstances outlined in this letter.




