I moved to Florida in 1998 and received my contractor's license in 1999. Being new in the state and now having a contractor's license, I am now having to learn what paperwork is required to stay current.

I have received all fees and bills that I have received for the Division of Corporations, however I never received your bills for \$150.00 per year and requests for annual reports. On June 1, 1999, I moved to accommodate the licensure regulations of the City of St. Augustine and the County of St. Johns, however my mail must not have been forwarded properly, as I never received any correspondence from your Division. I only learned of the revocation of my corporate status and the money owed to the State of Florida when I attempted to close a loan for a spec house and the closing attorney informed me that my corporation was inactive and I was unable to have the closing until the corporation was again allowed to do business in Florida. Had I known about this problem before today, I certainly would have paid the amount due and resolved the matter promptly so as not to jeopardize my business in Florida.

I plead with you to review this matter and to understand my unfortunate situation.
