Thank you for your letter of December 8, 1998 re: my request that the National Coalition of Advocates for Students, Inc. be registered to do business in Florida.

The National Coalition of Advocates for Students (NCAS) is a publicly supported charity granted 501c3 status by the U.S. Internal Revenue Service. (See attachment.) In the process of carrying out the organization's work, NCAS provides assistance that is closely related to its organizational purpose and mission to public education institutions, parent groups, and other community-based organizations. Some educational institutions pay NCAS for these services; however, none of the community-based groups do so.

As noted in documents which I recently submitted to the Florida Division of Corporations, NCAS has intermittently conducted such business in Florida in the recent past. However, I did not know until a few weeks ago that it was necessary to have state authorization to do so. When I learned that filing was required, I immediately did so. In view of these facts, NCAS requests a reduction in the penalties owed by NCAS to the state of Florida from the maximum (\$1,000 per year) to the minimum (\$500 per year). I have enclosed a check in the amount of \$245 to cover annual report fees.

Thank you for your consideration in this matter. I look forward to hearing from you at your earliest convenience. In case you wish to reach me by telephone, you should know that the NCAS office is closed from December 24, 1998 to January 4, 1999. However, I will be checking the general message line (617-357-8507) and returning phone calls daily on December 28, 29, 30 and 31.
