ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF INTERNATIONAL MERCANTILE MARINE CORP.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 607.1006, Florida Statutes, this Florida profit corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

1. Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE III

AUTHORIZED SHARES

The Corporation shall be authorized to create and issue 50,000 shares of common stock having no par value.

The whole or any part of the authorized shares of the Corporation may be issued for a consideration payable in cash or other property, tangible or intangible, or in labor or services actually performed for the Corporation, having a value as is determined from time to time by the Board of Directors of the Corporation, not less than the par value of the stock so to be issued.
