We are in receipt of the enclosed application for reinstatement, and were appalled at the fact that we apparently had not filed the corporate annual report back in April, 1998. A careful review of our records showed that no monies had been paid...nor was there a bill in our unpaid listing. This leads us to believe that we did not receive and unfortunately did not think about that prior to the early summer deadline.

I realize that this sounds like the "shoemaker that goes with shoes" because we are a CPA firm that handles this filing for numerous clients. In the administration of our practice, we obviously pay all of our tax and filing requirements in a timely fashion. And I can only indicate to you that if we had received it, we would have certainly paid this one too. Unfortunately, we also had a situation here where we had an administrative employee who was terminated, who had thrown out some of our mail prior to our knowledge of it's arrival. This has come back to haunt us for months now. The employee was terminated as soon as we determined the problem.

A review of our firm will indicate to you that we have a 16 year history of prompt and timely payments of any and all tax filings for our firm. In light of the extenuating circumstances surrounding this, we are respectfully asking that the penalty be waived in this particular instance, and that you please reinstate us as a corporation for the regular filing fee (enclosed).
