The above corporation recently received this application for reinstatement in the mail from your office, and was not aware that their Corporate Annual Report had not been filed. I recently spoke with someone in your office, and I was advised that Rio Cleaners should pay a \$300 fee, which represents the normal annual report fees for 1999, and the year 2000, and send a letter to you requesting in writing that any additional fees be waived. I was told this would not be a guarantee of the waiver of fees, but that under extenuating circumstances, your office did have the ability to reinstate the corporation by paying the regular normal fees.

Rio Cleaners, Inc. has been a client of mine for the past six years. We do their accounting on a monthly basis, and they are diligent in sending all taxing authority notices to us, for filing on a timely basis. During the past two years, Rio Cleaners assures me, and I have no reason to doubt, that they never received the Corporate Annual Report from your office. They have, as I have stated above, always been diligent in filing all returns on a timely basis, and would not have overlooked such an important matter. They have told me that this Application for Reinstatement was the first time they had received any notice that the Corporate Annual Report had not been paid.

I know that your office sends out the Annual Report, and two other notices, before the Corporation Administrative Dissolution or Revocation notices are sent out, but somehow, somehow there must have been some problem with the mail which caused them not to receive these notices, since they are so diligent in all other aspects of their filings.

The client, and I, respectfully request that you please consider waiving the additional fees, and allow them to reinstate this corporation for the enclosed \$300 fee, for the normal 1999 and 2000 fee. Thanks so much for your consideration in this matter.
