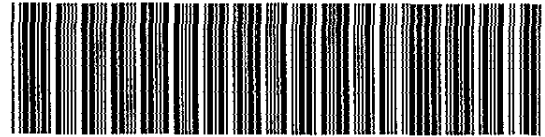

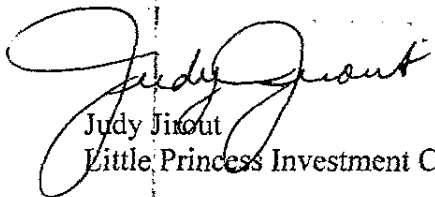
I also included the minutes of a duly called meeting of the Directors of Little Princess Investment Corp where the determination was made to dissolve this corporation.

by this Court. This Wife should receive her equitable and statutory benefits of the parties' marital labors during their long-term marriage.

M. Therefore, the Court finds, based on its analysis of the above factors, that there should be a disproportionate award of equitable distribution in favor of the Wife as set forth below to do justice between these parties.

N. The Court, pursuant to F.S. § 61.075 (3), makes the following specific findings of fact:

(a) The only non-marital assets are the Wife's retirement accounts acquired after the filing date, SEP Account with Morgan Stanley, IRA First Union, and IRA Roth, First Union, Golden Rule Medical Savings Plan, and Wachovia brokerage account, and those accounts are hereby set aside and awarded to the Wife.

(b) The marital assets of these parties at the time of final hearing, which the Court finds to be the relevant date for reviewing said holdings and valuing those marital holdings, are to be distributed as follows:

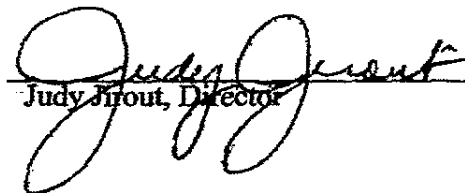
