We are responding on behalf of the above-referenced taxpayer to your notice dated November 20, 2002, a copy of which is enclosed.

The 2002 Uniform Business Report (UBR) was timely filed by the taxpayer in January 2002. At that time, Ferazzoli Construction Corp. relied on the services and expertise of their Certified Public Accountant in New York. Apparently, that accountant was unaware of Florida's requirements with regard to proper signatures and the UBR was rejected.

The taxpayer signed the UBR and gave it back to the CPA for filing. The taxpayer believed their accountant properly re-filed the UBR. Also enclosed is a copy of the cancelled check, which had been attached to the UBR that was filed in January 2002. Since the check had been deposited by the Florida Department of State, it appeared to the taxpayer that his UBR had been accepted.

Later in the year, the taxpayer became increasingly dissatisfied with the accountant's performance and fired him. Only when Ferazzoli Construction Corp. retrieved and reviewed their files from the accountant, did they realize that the UBR had never been refiled. The taxpayer immediately took steps to correct the problem.

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As the taxpayer relied on advice from its accountant, as to the preparation and filing of the UBR, the taxpayer has acted reasonably and in good faith. There was no prejudice to the interest of the State of Florida. Therefore, we respectfully request that Ferazzoli Construction Corp.'s Application for Reinstatement, which is attached, be accepted and that all penalties be abated.
