CJW, INC., a Florida corporation, executes the following articles of dissolution pursuant to section 607.1403 of the Florida Business Corporation Act:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is CJW, INC. (the "company").

SECOND: The company's articles of incorporation were filed on May 20, 1985 under the name SOUTHERN CRUSHING SERVICE, INC.. The company filed Amended Articles of Incorporation on May 6, 1999, by which the company's name was changed to CJW, INC.

THIRD: The company does not have any unpaid debt.


FOURTH: The shareholders voted unanimously on the 16 day of December, 2000 to dissolve the company.
