Dear Mrs. Harris:

I am writing this letter in follow-up to the instructions of  
"Marie" from the Department of State to me on June 22, 2000.  
"Marie" recommended I write this letter in an effort to: 1.) Make  
an "Exception" to the late filing of our UBR's due to  
"Circumstances beyond the employer's control and 2.) Not to be  
monetarily penalized by the State Dept. for these late filings."

As reflected on the top copy of the UBR's, our Accounting  
Department received them on January 3, 2000. The Accounting  
Manager set them up in the Accounts Payable File for April 28,  
2000 for payment to be disbursed and mailed to the Department of  
State. Obviously, this task was never performed. From the  
information gathered to date by our staff, the UBR's must have  
been pulled prior to April 28th by the Accounting Manager to  
disburse payment. The only problem being the Accounting Manager  
quit without notice on April 26, 2000. Both UBR's were found with  
several other unpaid bills in the April, 2000 "PAID EXPENDITURES"  
file folder for the firm. We are still asking ourselves WHY  
anyone would intentionally file unpaid bills away in "Paid" bills  
knowing that within days, no more than weeks, someone internally  
or our CPA would pick up on the error(s).

As reflected by your records, we have NEVER defaulted with  
registering with the Division of Corporations in over sixteen  
years of being in business. The justification, I presume, for  
"Marie's" instructing me to write this "Exception" letter to  
accompany both UBR filings, along with our Corporate check in the  
amount of \$300.00. Please accept my most humble apology.

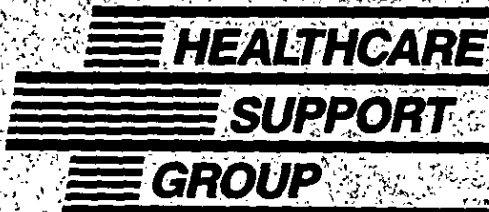

Dear Mrs. Harris:

I am requesting your assistance relating to the above referenced matter. I believe the attached documentation clearly depicts the predicament our Company was placed, when our Accounting Manager quit without notice this past April. As related in my June 30, 2000 letter (attached), I carefully followed the specific instructions of "Maria" from the Division of Corporations as to how to respond to the Annual Reports Section for the late filing for the above referenced entities. The gratitude shown by the Annual Reports Section for following these instructions was to receive a curt, unsigned letter (attached) penalizing us \$800.00 for discovering and reporting this oversight. My June 30th letter resulted with extremely blunt and very callous treatment. Needless to say, I was insulted and infuriated by the Annual Reports Section's June 14, 2000 letter. When our staff discovered the Annual Reports in late June, they immediately brought the Reports to my attention. Fully realizing the Reports had not been filed, I called the Division Of Corporations to not only make the State aware of the problem we had discovered, but to also seek the State's recommendations relating to this matter. Our reward for this forthright conduct with attempting to explain, in detail, the reason for our not filing the Annual Reports in a timely manner was nothing short of severe financial penalties. Severe penalties totalling \$800 or almost three times the cost of the original filing fees! The Annual Reports Section's letter dated July 14, 2000 was totally unsympathetic to the dilemma our staff had discovered. HONESTY DOES NOT PAY! The Annual Report Section's letter proves it. It has become the principal of the matter at this point. BIG GOVERNMENT bureaucracy working at its best (worst) at least in this Department. BIG GOVERNMENT bureaucracy was one of Governor Bush's primary platforms during his recent election campaign.


Dear Madam/Sir:



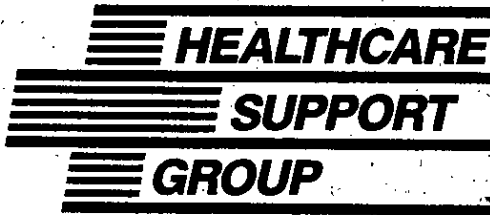
