On January 1, 1960, the Commission signed with the United States, Canada, Mexico and Haiti, for the purpose of creating a "Free Area" in the Caribbean, a Declaration of Principles, which provided that the countries included in the present report, as signatories, would respect the freedom of trade and that they, separately and jointly, would endeavor to create a free trade area. The Declaration was a reflection of the cooperation of the United States and the Caribbean Community to create the type of an organization to be known as the Caribbean Community, and that the member countries of the Caribbean Community would be free to trade with each other.
