
I, as President of J.R.'S SUNSET, INC., request that you waive the \$600.00 reinstatement fee for the Corporation's failure to file an annual report based on reasonable cause and good faith. The Corporation failed to file an annual report and was subsequently dissolved for the failure to do so because I was out of the State of Florida, and I was unable to get an annual report filed in 2001. Because the Corporation was in the process of selling all of its assets, we did not file the annual report upon my return and were proceeding to wind up the Corporation; however, the prospective purchaser has defaulted under the agreement to purchase the assets and as such, reinstatement of the Corporation is necessary to hold the assets.

We have taken appropriate steps to have the Corporation reinstated and, more importantly, have learned the importance of the annual filing requirements. From hereon, the Corporation shall timely file the annual report and pay the appropriate fees. Therefore, based on the foregoing, I request that the Department of State waive the reinstatement fee and accept our enclosed Corporation Reinstatement and payment of \$750.00 for the Corporation's annual reporting fee for 2001 through 2005.
