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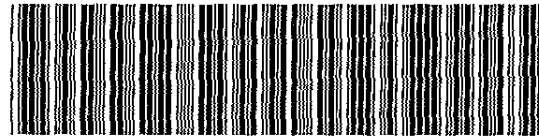

Pursuant to the provisions of sections 607.1006 and 621.13(4), Florida Statutes, this Florida profit corporation adopts the following amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I: The name of the corporation (which may sometimes hereafter be referred to as the "Corporation") is changed to

BKRY Maternal Child Network, Inc.


ARTICLE II: The Corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida, excluding the rendering of any professional services governed by Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes.

The principal office of the Corporation shall be 1200 South Pine Island Road, Plantation, Florida 33324, with the privilege of having its offices at other places within or without the State of Florida, and the registered agent for the Corporation shall be CT Corporation System, 1200 South Pine Island Road, Plantation, Florida 33324.

The amendments were adopted on February 10, 2004 and shall be effective upon the filing of these Articles of Amendment.

The amendments were adopted by the board of directors without shareholder action and shareholder action was not required.
