Sir/Madam:

I received my "Second Notice" correspondence from your office yesterday and was confused as I had never received a "First Notice". When I read the amount due (\$550), I was even more confused and, upon checking my records, noted that I had only paid \$150 over the previous years.

So, today I telephoned your office to inquire why the fees had increased so dramatically. It was then that I was notified that the fee was due by May 1st and that I was being penalized \$400 for being late! Nowhere on the form was that explained other than in the "Frequently Asked Questions" section. I would never have been prompted to contact your office had I not thought the fee excessive and, I would never have been informed that I had missed the deadline.

The gentleman that I spoke with suggested that I enclose my check for \$150 with a letter explaining that I never received the first notice and ask that I not be penalized as I have always paid on time over the last eleven years. If you check our records, you will also find that we pay our Sales Tax and every other state fee on a timely basis. We are a small business concern and this type of penalty is a burden for us.

I have notated on my calendar that this fee is due by May 1st every year so that this will not happen again. Please advise if this is not acceptable.
