The people who are buying their places are younger & not buying from us. So our sales have decreased by 60% from 5 years ago. The new people are more to buying at T.T. Mart & Wal-Mart.

I hope that we make it into our busy season when the snow birds come down in January.

I almost had a heart attack when I saw the form paid \$150 because we never paid that much before.

We never did receive the first mailing. At that time we probably had enough to pay the \$165 fee. The lady that I spoke to paid to send in the original fee.
