Dear Tina:

Thank you for your assistance in getting our filing straightened out.

As you will recall, we spoke at the end of June regarding the filing of our two corporations, Kohn & Company, Inc. – K57381 – and Graymark Security Group – P94000037224. On April 11, we had submitted payment for both corporations on one check along with the proper documents for both and a check that was clearly identified as payment of the two fees. Someone posted the entire amount to the Graymark account and showed the other account as unpaid. Per your instructions, I completed another report for Kohn & Company and submitted this along with a letter of explanation and a copy of our check in case they needed to confirm my statements. (Attachment 1)

We then received a letter dated July 15 from Tyrone Scott stating that you had received the document as well as the check for Kohn & Company. I had signed the report at #8 where I had indicated a change of address but, unfortunately, had neglected to sign it again at #12. He asked that I sign the form and send a letter requesting fee abatement. On July 23 I transmitted this letter along with the executed form. (Attachments 2 & 3)

Today we received another letter, dated August 9, from Gary Blankenbaker. This letter says that you have received the documents – which I know that you have now received 3 times – but no money has been received. He wants me to send a check for \$550.00. (Attachment 4)


Tina, please get this mess taken care of! In 15 years of filing we have never gone through anything like this. I still cannot understand how someone could have posted an overpayment on the one account without questioning it. Do you actually have companies that pay these fees in advance? I also cannot understand how your agents could not look at attached paperwork and not read letters of explanation that are submitted. With each submission, I have included the entire history of what has occurred and received back all

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of my submissions! I don't know what else to do except hope that you are as bright and understanding as you indicated on the telephone.

Please call me, before sending me another letter, if you need any other information.



I spoke with "Tina" in your office who found that someone had applied a \$300.00 payment to our other account, P94000037224 Graymark Security Group. I would have thought that who ever was posting what should have been only \$150.00 would have questioned the overpayment but apparently they did not. Tina explained that I needed to send a letter stating what occurred and request that an adjustment be made.

Included is another annual report form that also includes a change of address, which occurred after we had submitted the other forms. I am not sure why the website is not correct as your mailing to me has the correct address indicating that you did receive the change that I had previously filed for both companies. I have also enclosed a copy of our check should you need to research the payment for your clarification.

Please adjust your records to show the correct address for both companies and the correct timely payment for each as well. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter.
