Dear Administrator:

I am writing this letter as explanation for my apparently tardy corporate filings. I am deeply distressed by what has happened.

I have recently (October 2, 2002) been notified of a name change for my corporation from Business Valuation & Development Associates, Inc. (the old name) to Business Value Associates (the new name). This name change is correct.


After receipt of notice of the name change I attempted to register the fictitious name Business Value Associates. It was then and only then that I was informed that the corporation had gone inactive on October 4, 2002; this is a status that I had no idea was even contemplated or near.

I can only assume that I did not receive my Uniform Business Report (UBR) or notices this year as the only explanation that makes any sense as to why I would not have paid my registration fees.
