Pursuant to the provisions of §607.1006, <u>Florida Statutes</u>, this Florida profit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Magic Detailing, Inc.

ARTICLE II NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

- a. To engage in the business of automobile detailing, cleaning and refinishing.
- b. To engage in the business of home and office janitorial services.
- c. To engage in any commercial, industrial, and agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation.
- d. To generally engage in, do and perform, any enterprise, act, or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform.
- e. To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidence of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property or other instruments to secure payment of corporate indebtedness as required.
